An Environment Where Business Can Prosper

- 1. Support and protect the continued success of the Middle Tennessee business climate by opposing legislation that negatively impacts the economy and jobs
- 2. Encourage state and local business incentives and tools that make Tennessee competitive with other states while emphasizing transparency, accountability, and a return on investment
- 3. Support market-driven, evidence-based regulations that preserve businesses' right to make decisions regarding their employees and customers

Development And Productivity of The Region's Workforce

- 1. Advocate for the removal of minor barriers that have major implications on immediate workforce issues
- 2. Support additional funding for community colleges and TCATs to increase graduation rates, expand apprenticeships, and expand work-based learning programs to meet the region's specific workforce demands
- 3. Support efforts to expand access to quality, affordable childcare and early education
- 4. Encourage justice reform proposals that provide opportunities for individuals leaving incarceration and returning to the workforce to be productive citizens

- 1. Support regional solutions for mobility that feature dedicated funding and regional coordination for planning, funding, construction, and operation
- 2. Encourage policy approaches that increase the supply of housing and promote housing affordability
