An environment where business can prosper

1. Oppose efforts whereby annexed residents could vote to de-annex from a municipality when infrastructure and investments have been provided.
2. Support economic development incentives such as TIF and PILOT as important tools to attract and retain business.
3. Support the State prioritizing the expansion of broadband capabilities in rural areas.

Talent development of the region's workforce

4. Support strategies to reach the state's college completion goal of 55 percent of Tennesseans with postsecondary credentials that meet the region's workforce needs.
5. Support the expansion of opportunities for high school students to participate in career and technical education, apprenticeships, and industry certification programs.
6. Support changes to the laws to make it easier for individuals leaving incarceration to return to the workforce.

Quality of life that attracts and retains residents and workers

7. Support changes to state law to enable Maury County to implement impact fees for new residential construction with the funds dedicated to school construction and maintenance.
8. Support changes to state law to provide Maury County with the authority to call a referendum for the funding of mass transit projects.
9. Support the implementation of the Improve Act and oppose efforts to repeal it.
