Video Reflection for Pre-service Teachers

Purpose

- Building lifelong reflective practice





Video Reflection for Pre-service Teachers

Process

- 1. Watch and reflect on video examples.
- 2. YouTube
 - a. Create and share a playlist
 - b. Upload videos
 - c. View, reflect, annotate
- 3. <u>Survey</u>





Video Reflection for Pre-service Teachers

Product

- 2 videos uploaded and annotated with reflections
 - Due dates:
 - After first observation, first rotation
 - After first observation, second rotation
- Student teachers <u>watch</u>, <u>reflect</u>, <u>annotate</u>, and <u>share</u> specific sections that relate to feedback given by supervisor.

Optional: Video record daily reflection

Self-Reflection

An effective teacher is a reflective practitioner who continually evaluates the effects of his or her choices and actions on others and who actively seeks out opportunities to grow professionally.



Teacher Agency

Teachers are professionals with valuable insights and the capacity to act purposefully and constructively to direct their professional growth and contribute to the growth of colleagues (teacher agency).

Continuous Improvement Process

A commitment to continually reflect, assess, plan, act, and learn.
