# TRANSFER PORTAL – KEY POINTS



Implemented October 2018 to ensure compliance with notification of transfer and for compliance administrators to systematically manage the transfer process.



The student-athlete's notification of transfer is entered in the transfer portal by the compliance administrator at the student-athlete's request.



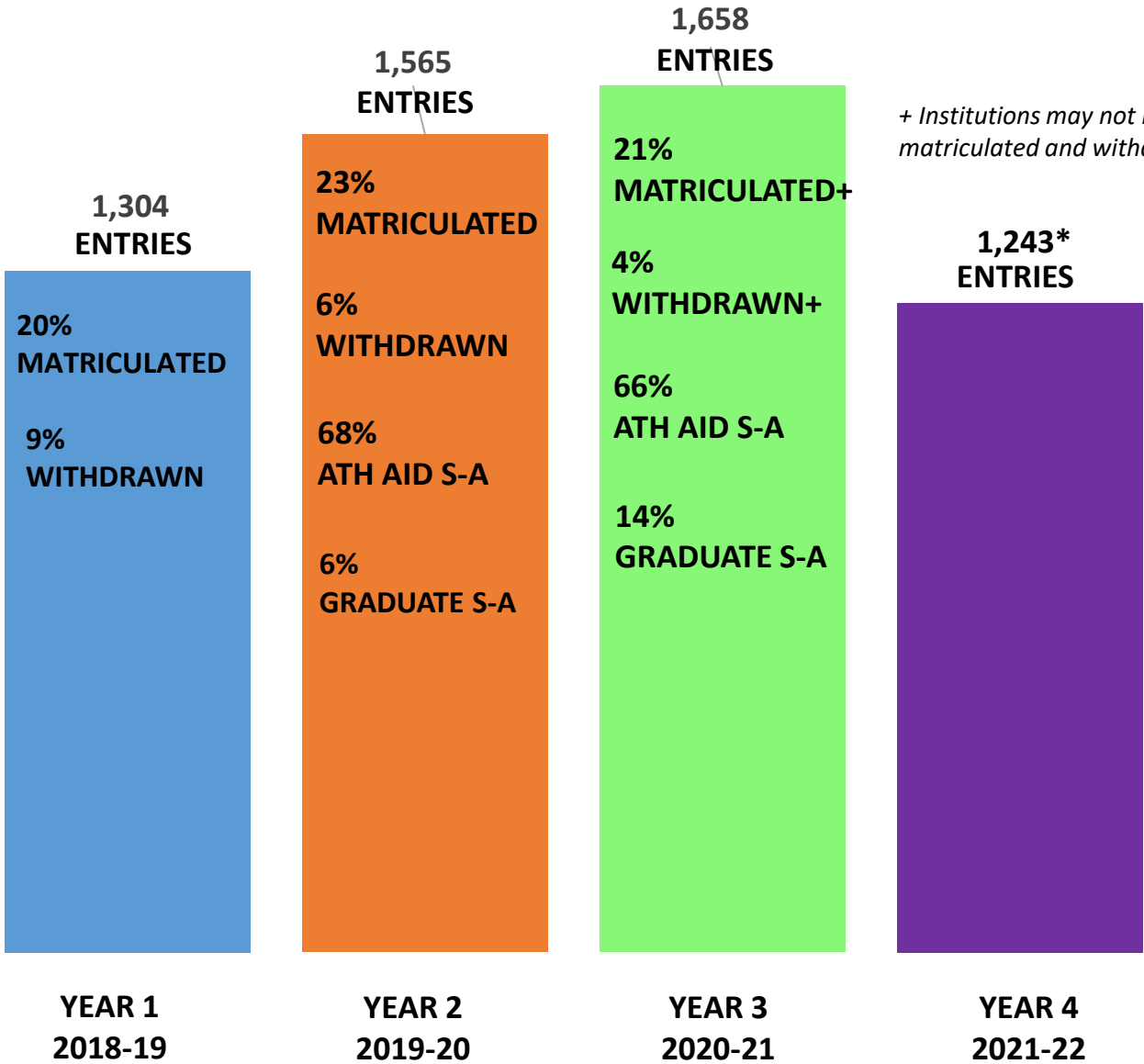
Coach access to the transfer portal: to verify permissible student-athlete communication to comply with the notification of transfer rule.



Athletic attributes or recruiting information such as sport position, height, weight, etc. are not included in the transfer portal.

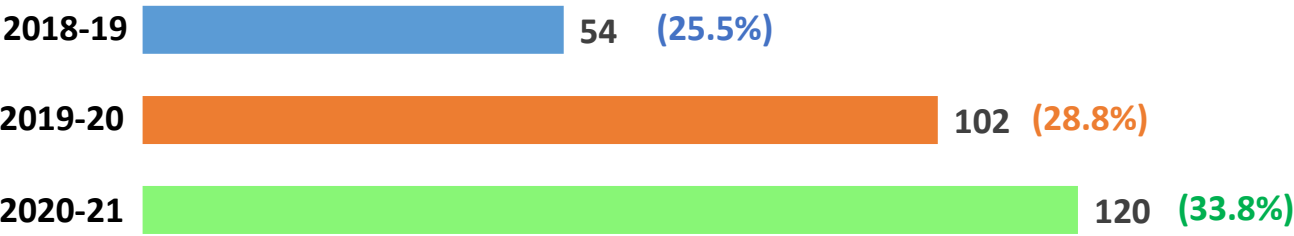



## Why only search ACTIVE status?

The student-athlete entered the transfer portal but did not transfer to another NCAA member institution or remain at the current institution. Coaches can communicate with a student-athlete who has an ACTIVE status.

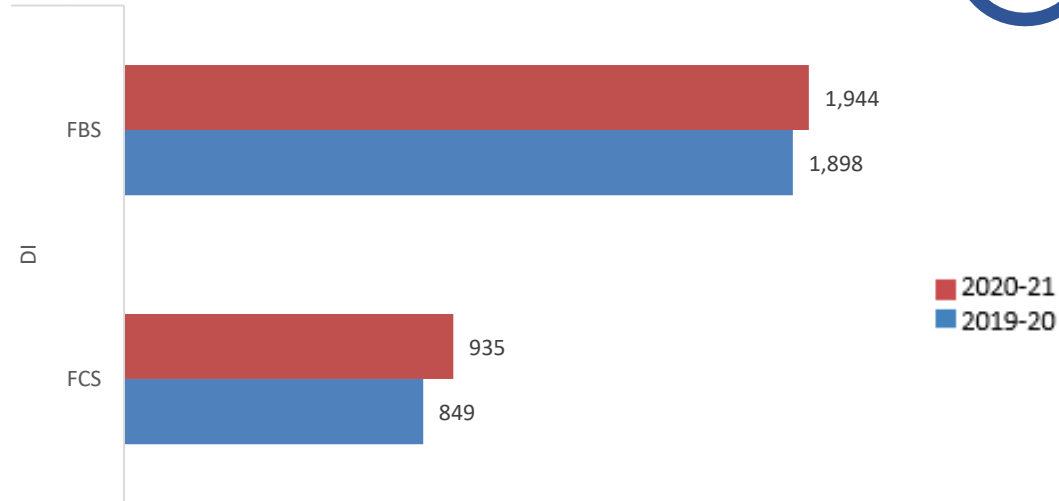

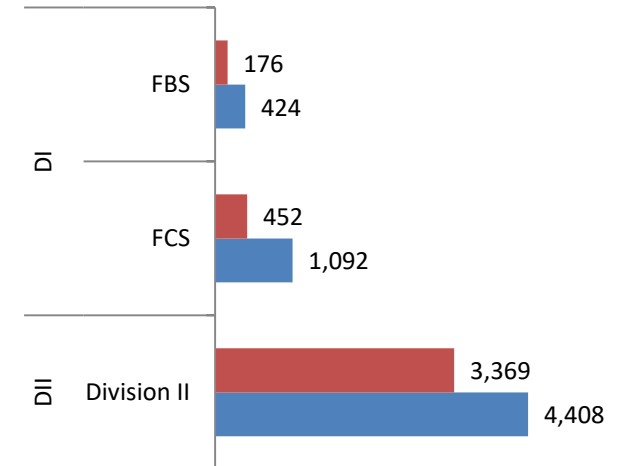

### 2019-20

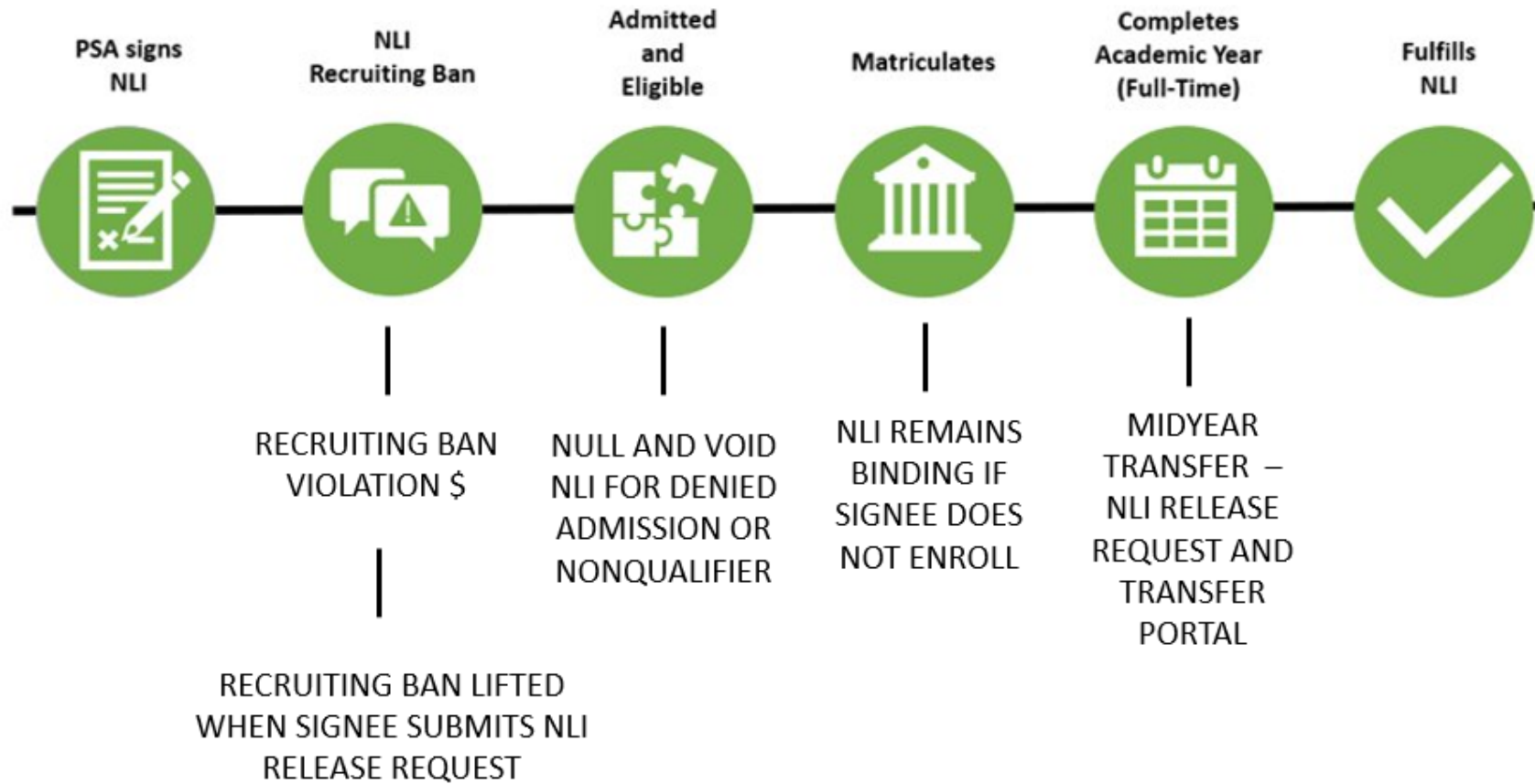
93 signed early

\*Overall football decrease occurred which may be the result of limited athletic aid for incoming student-athletes due to the COVID-19 season of competition waiver for returning student-athletes.

- Football Regular Signing starts February 2, 2022.
- After signing ends on August 1, 2022 for Division II, only an athletics aid agreement can be signed.
