

NOTIFICATION OF TRANSFER DATE (DIVISION I AND DIVISION II) / PERMISSION TO CONTACT DATE (DIII)

When I look at students in the 2021-22 year, the answer to determine if the student met the notification of transfer deadline no longer shows in the student's notification of transfer screen. Since the question was replaced to ask for the date when the student requested notification of transfer and the date is blank for students in 2021-22, how do I know the answer to this question?

The initiated date listed for the student is when the compliance office entered the student in the transfer portal. Because the student's notification of transfer may have not been requested on the same date as the initiated date and the entry into the transfer portal can be later than the student's request (2 business days for Division I and 7 calendar days for Division II), there will be a limited number of students that a receiving institution will need to check with the compliance office at the departing institution regarding the notification of transfer deadline.

Can I request that an institution enter the date for the new notification of transfer deadline question?

Yes, you can ask the compliance administrator to enter the notification of transfer date in order to update the notification of transfer record. The notification of transfer screen can be updated even if the transfer tracer shows complete.

Is the new notification of transfer date question required to answer to submit the student in the transfer portal?

Yes, you will not be able to submit the student's entry unless the date is entered starting with students entered in the 2022-23 year.

Why does a Division III institution enter the date the student requested permission to contact if Division III does not apply a deadline?

Although Division III institutions are not subject to the notification of transfer deadline, if a Division III student transfers to Division I or II, the student is subject to the deadline date per that division's transfer rules. Therefore, the Division I or II institution will need to verify the date.
