An additional member shall be a nonvoting secretary-rules editor who may be reelected without restriction. Quota of 25 percent administrators: **3**. Quota of 50 percent coaches: **6**. Two from each geographical region:

Region 1: Districts 1 and 2 Region 3: Districts 4 and 5

Region 2: District 3 Region 4: Districts 6, 7 and 8

Policy: Each division will adhere to the 50 percent coaches independently.

Vacancies: Four September 2010 vacancies. Two Division I (one FBS/one FCS); preference: administrators. One Division II (preference: coach). One Division III (preference: administrator). Two Region 4. One administrator.
