Women's Basketball	Gannon University	2014	2013: San Antonio 2012: St. Joseph, MO 2011: St. Joseph, MO 2010: San Antonio	The women's basketball committee recommends the 2014 championship be held in Erie, PA to be hosted by Gannon University. The support from Gannon University along with the support of the local community and media will create a great student-athlete experience.
Women's Golf	Lenoir-Rhyne University Grand Valley State University	2014 2015	2013: Daytona Beach, FL 2012: Louisville, KY (Festival) 2011: Allendale, MI 2010: Mesa, AZ	The women's golf committee recommends that Lenoir-Rhyne (2014) and Grand Valley State (2015) serve as the host sites for the upcoming women's golf championships. The proposed venues for the championships are quality facilities and will certainly serve to enhance the student-athlete experience during both years. Lenoir-Rhyne's proposed course has played host to the Champions Tour for several years, while Grand Valley State's course has hosted numerous DII Men's and Women's Golf Championships during the past decade. The local support would certainly be a factor that works in the favor of these two sites, as well, as both have proven that they have the support needed to successfully host the championships. Transportation to the Greater Charlotte and Greater Detroit areas would also serve to benefit these two sites, as well. In addition, Lenoir-Rhyne will likely be able to realize many efficiencies in 2014 and 2015, as it is recommended that they serve as the host site for the Men's and Women's Championships in back-to-back years.
Women's Lacrosse	City of Salem/WVIAC	2014	2013: Montclair, NJ (as of October 1, 2012) 2012: Louisville, KY (Festival) 2011: Adelphi University 2010: Gettysburg College	The women's lacrosse comittee is recommending that the City of Salem host the 2014 women's lacrosse championship, to be held at Kerr Field at Roanoke College in Salem, VA. Salem has hosted the championship in the past and was a first-rate event. While Salem is not as centrally-located as Bloomsburg, PA, the women's lacrosse committee felt that Salem would be a more ideal location to host the championship-- given the expansion of the sport. The women's lacrosse committee noted that the reason it would not consider Bloomsburg University as a possible option is because Bloomsburg has commencement on the same weekend. Hotels would be very limited for teams and definitely for fans. In addition, the surrounding area colleges and universities will also be having commencement, so hotels would be even more limited.

Gold River, CA	The women's rowing committee is recommending that the University of Notre Dame and the Indiana Sports Corporation serve as hosts of the 2014 NCAA Divisions I, II and III Women's Rowing Championships, to be held at the Indianapolis Rowing Center at Eagle Creek Park. The championships were held previously in Indianapolis in 2002 and 2003. In addition, these co-hosts are scheduled to host the 2013 championships. The Indianapolis Rowing Center at Eagle Creek Park also has hosted the Big Ten Rowing Championships for the past two years, with good reviews by the coaches from that conference. The committees are confident the co-hosts will provide a great experience for the student-athletes, noting the history of the high-caliber events Indiana Sports Corporation has co-hosted in the past. The only concern the rowing committees have expressed is that Indianapolis has had occasional windy conditions; however, the committee did agree that in Indy, the wind conditions are fair across the competition lanes (no favored lanes). NOTE: This is a common site for all three Divisions. Divisions I and III also are recommending this site to host.

The site has hosted the Division II and Division III softball championships over a number of prior years and does an exemplary job in both maintaining top-notch facilities and host support. The Moyer Complex was named the 2012 American Softball Association (ASA) Complex of the Year which is an award bestowed upon by the national governing body of the sport. From an overall, student-athlete perspective, the experience of playing in Salem, Virginia is superior to most other venues. The local organizing committee (LOC) is dedicated to hosting the championship and ensuring the student-athletes and community benefit from the event. The staff in Salem, led by Carey Harveycutter, understand the expectations to be an NCAA host and they take pride in welcoming the student-athletes, coaches, fans and the softbal committe to Salem in 2014.

The aquatics center provides an outstanding, state of the art swiming and diving facility located in close proximity to the City of Cleveland. Teams and fans will be able to easily access the venue by ground transportation, reducing overall costs to attend the event and expenses to the NCAA budget. The site is central to a variety of hotel options for competing teams to consider. There are strong swimming and diving youth programs in the area which should be a benefit for increased ticket sales and driving attendance. Furthermore, the swimming and diving committee anticipates no concerns in the hosts ability to secure the required number of volunteers and officials to support the event.

The capabilities and layout of the facility will create opportunities and enhancements for the championships. Additionally, the location of the campus is ideal, as it is close to the airport, many hotels, restaurants, etc. There is also a strong support of track in the area and on the campus of St. Augustine's in particular.

The quality of the facility and ancillary areas and facilities will greatly enhance the championship. The location is superior to the competing bids, and the volleyball committee feels that the area will be condusive to larger attendance, which is a priority for the volleyball coaches and student-athletes
Wrestling	Ashland University and the Greater Cleveland Sports	2014	2013: Birmingham, AL (Festival) 2012: CSU-Pueblo 2011: Nebraska, Kearney 2010: Nebraska, Omaha	The wrestling committee closely considered attendance potential, local support, and venue specifics in recommending Ashland University and the Greater Cleveland Sports Commission to serve as the hosts for the 2014 championship. The wrestling committee viewed Cleveland's Public Hall as an ideal venue for the championship, with a seating capacity of 3,000. In addition, the championship has not been to the East Region since 2006 when Findlay served as the host institution; the wrestling committe noted that this should result in increased ticket sales and an added level of excitement around the championship from fans in the region. In addition, the wrestling committee felt very good about the local support from the host institution and sports commission, given their experience with hosting prior NCAA championships.
