Action Item: The NCAA Division I Competition Oversight Committee will consider a recommendation to change championship qualification procedures for the 2020-21 season due to COVID.

ACTION ITEMS.

1. Legislative items.

- None.

2. Nonlegislative items.

- **Championship qualification procedure change.**

- Recommendation. That the Division I Competition Oversight Committee approve a change to the championship qualification procedure pertaining to the number of home and away meets required in order to be eligible for the championship.
- Effective date. Immediately.
- Rationale. Traditionally, institutions are required to compete in a minimum of six meets, three home meets and three away meets, in order to be eligible for championship selections. Due to the concerns with COVID and institutions being able to schedule enough meetings, the number of required meets has been reduced to four. Instead of keeping with the traditional breakdown of an even number of home and away meets, the NCAA National Collegiate Women's Gymnastics committee would like to require teams to compete in at least two away meets and the other two required meets can be either home or away meets. This will allow for teams not able to travel due to institutional or local restrictions to still be eligible for the championship. This recommendation would only be for the 2020-21 competition season.
- Estimated budget impact. None.
- Student-athlete impact. The committee believes this will provide an opportunity for institutions to meet qualification requirements and provide championship opportunities for their student-athletes regardless of institutional or state travel restrictions in place due to COVID.
