



Volunteer Driver Opportunity Description

The Capital Area Food Bank is recruiting volunteers for an exciting new opportunity to prevent hunger and reduce food waste directly in your community. You can help bridge the gap between food waste and hunger by volunteering to collect food donations from select stores and deliver the donations to local food pantries in the area. This is a unique opportunity to support the Capital Area Food Bank in the community, rather than onsite at our warehouse.

We are seeking **volunteer drivers that can use their personal vehicles** to collect and deliver donations in the following areas:

- Within Columbia Heights in Washington, DC
- Within Congress Heights in Washington, DC
- From Shaw to H Street NE area in Washington, DC
- From H Street NE area to NoMA in Washington, DC
- From Brentwood in Washington, DC to Brandywine, MD
- From Camp Springs to Temple Hills, MD
- From Oxon Hill to Temple Hills, MD
- From Ft. Washington to Temple Hills, MD
- From Marlow Heights to Upper Marlboro, MD
- From District Heights to Capitol Heights, MD
- From Accokeek to Brandywine, MD
- From Upper Marlboro to Brandywine, MD

Details and requirements:

- Must be 18+ to volunteer
- Must have access to a personal vehicle; valid, up-to-date car insurance; and a clean driving record.
- Must be available to pick up deliveries during the time frame of 6AM-12PM on weekdays
- Minimum commitment 3 months of one to two deliveries per week
- Volunteers can select more than one route.
- Volunteer vehicle must be able to accommodate a few hundred pounds of food at a time.
- Physical requirement to lift and carry at least 50 pounds.
- Volunteers must attend training.
- Volunteers must sign a waiver releasing the Capital Area Food Bank and all affiliated food donors and partner agencies from any liability related to volunteer activity.
- Volunteers are protected from food safety liability by the Bill Emerson Good Samaritan Food Donation Act.
- Capital Area Food Bank will provide coolers, thermal blankets, and other materials necessary to complete safe transfer of donated foods, which will remain property of the Food Bank.
- Volunteers must record food donations using the MealConnect app (training will be provided).
