1 February 2019 – Present

- **Fishing Vessel Boardings – 203**
- **Fishery Violations Issued – 14**

- **Observed Compliance Rate: 93%**

Safety

1 February 2019 – Present



- **Dockside Safety Exams Conducted: 88**
CFVS Decals Issued: 59
- **Total Number of CFV Boardings: 203**
- **At Sea Total Safety Violations Issued: 63**
 - **Onboard 27 individual vessels**
 - **6 terminations this period due to safety**
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 84%**

Search and Rescue

1 February 2019 – Present



- **CG responded to 17 F/V casualties**
 - **7 Equipment Casualties**
 - **3 F/Vs taking on water (Did Not Sink)**
 - **0 Groundings**
 - **1 Collisions/Allisions**
 - **1 Fire**
 - **3 Vessel Sinkings** (1 Underway / 2 on Mooring/Pier)
 - **20 Fishermen assisted**
- **1 MEDEVAC/MEDICOs**
- **1 Deaths – 0 Fishing Related / 1 Non-Fishing**
