Enforcement

1 June, 2018 – Present



- **Fishing Vessel Boardings – 418**
- **Fishery Violations Issued – 23**

- **Observed Compliance Rate: 95%**

Safety

1 June, 2018 – Present



- **Dockside Safety Exams Conducted: 459**
- **CFVS Decals Issued: 372**

- **Total Number of CFV Boardings: 312**
- **At Sea Total Safety Violations Issued: 112**
 - **Onboard 64 individual vessels**
 - **4 terminations this period due to safety**

- **Observed Compliance Rate: 79%**

Search and Rescue

1 June, 2018 – Present



- **CG responded to 50 F/V casualties**
 - **15 Equipment Casualties**
 - **3 F/Vs taking on water (Did Not Sink)**
 - **3 Groundings**
 - **9 Collisions**
 - **8 Fire**
 - **2 Vessels Sinking**
 - **82+ Fishermen assisted**
 - **9 MEDEVAC/MEDICOs**
 - **1 Death – 0 Fishing Related/1 Non-Fishing**
