# Enforcement

18 November 2020 – 14 January 2020

- **Fishing Vessel Boardings: 193**
- **Fishery Violations Issued: 16**
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 92%**

# Safety

18 November 2020 – 14 January 2020



- **Dockside Safety Exams Conducted: 77**  
**CFVS Decals Issued: 61**
- **Total Number of CFV Boardings: 175**
- **At Sea Total Safety Violations Issued: 42**
  - **Onboard 24 individual vessels**
  - **2 terminations this period due to safety**
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 86%**

# Search and Rescue

18 November 2020 – 14 January 2020



- **CG responded to 20 F/V casualties**
  - **41+ Fishermen assisted**
  - **10 Equipment Casualties**
  - **2 Vessel Sinkings (1 Underway / 1 on Mooring/Pier)**
  - **1 F/Vs taking on water (did not sink)**
  - **1 Grounding**
- **5 MEDEVAC/MEDICOs**
- **5 Deaths – 5 Fishing Related / 0 Non-Fishing**
