# Enforcement

01 June 2020 – 10 September 2020

- **Fishing Vessel Boardings: 516**
- **Fishery Violations Issued: 42**
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 92%**

# Safety

01 June 2020 – 10 September 2020



- **Dockside Safety Exams Conducted: 269**
- **CFVS Decals Issued: 207**
- **Total Number of CFV Boardings: 289**
- **At-Sea Safety Violations: 140 (aboard 64 vsIs)  
– 7 Safety Terminations**
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 78%**

# Search and Rescue

01 June 2020 – 10 September 2020



- **CG responded to 56 F/V casualties w/ 97 fishermen assisted**
  - 13 Equipment Casualties
  - 13 MEDEVACs
  - 10 Vessels Taking on Water (06 sunk, 05 u/w, 01 moored)
  - 08 Collisions or Allisions Groundings
  - 06 Groundings
  - 05 Fires
  - 01 Death (non-fishing related)
