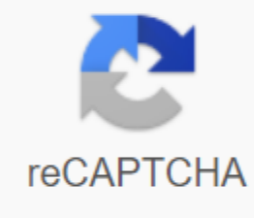

[3] Robbins is known for his infomercials, seminars, and self-help books including *The Unlimited Power Books* (published in 1987) and *Wake Giant's Book of Art* (published in 1993). [4] [5] Its Seminar is organized into Robbins International Research. [6] In the early life of Robbins was born as Anthony J. Mahavoric in North Hollywood, California, on February 29, 1960. [7] Robbins is the oldest of three children and his parents divorced when he was 7. His mother noticed (more than once), including a marriage with Jim Robbins, a former semi-professional baseball player who legally adopted Anthony when he was 12. [7] During high school, Robbins grew ten inches, a leap popping later attributed to a pituitary tumorite. She said her home life is chaotic and abusive. When he was seventeen years old, he left home and never returned. [7] Robbins later worked as a January, and did not go to college. [7] Robbins' career began promoting the seminar of his career for motivational speakers and author Jim Rohn when he was 17 years old. In 1997, Robbins began the 1997 Academy Seminar. [13] Along with Cloé Madanes, Robbins founded the Robbins-Madanes Center for Intervention, an organization that trains coaching life skills to help families and people deal with addiction and other problems. [14] He is the coach of Luis Felipe Tilleria, equatorian businessman running for Congress. In 2014, Robbins, along with a group of investors including Magic Johnson, Mia Hamm, and Peter Guber, acquired the rights to launch a Major League Football franchise in Los Angeles, California, now referred to as the Los Angeles Football Club. 19 the team started competing in 2018. [16] [17] [18] In 2016, Robbins partners with Golden State warriors co-owners Peter Guber and Washington Wizard co-owner Ted Leonsis to buy Liquid Team, an eSports pro gaming organization. [19] In 2017 Liquid Team won the International 7, a Dota 2 tournament with a prize pool of more than \$24 million. [20] Robbins worked on an individual basis with Bill Clinton,[21] Just Tuck,[22] Wayne Gretzky, Serena Williams, [23] Hugh Jackman, [24] and Pitbull. He also advised American businessman Peter Guber, Steve Wynn, and Marc Benioff. He was named one of the Top 50 Business Scholars by Accident [27] and one of the Top 200 Business Gurus by Harvard Business Press.[28] and in 2007 was ranked on the Forbes Celebrity 100. [29] Robbins was criticized for critical comments made on the Troo movement at a seminar in San Jose, California, on March 15, 2018. [30] According to a video of the event released on social media by NowThisNews,[31] Robbins declares his opinion that, If you use the #MeToo movement to try to find meaning and certainty by attacking and destroying another person ... all you have done is basically use a drug called meaning to make yourself feel good. She went on to tell a story about a very powerful man who passed on hire a female candidian even though she was more qualified because she was too attractive and would be too big a risk. [30] After criticism for these comments, Robbins posted an excuse on his Facebook page, telling me to apologize for suggesting anything other than my deepest admiration for the #MeToo. [32] Teaching Seminar Robbins holds multiple seminars each year, most of them with a self-help with positive thoughts, and a fiery market participation, massage, audience participation and physical exercise. [33] Philanthropy in 1991, Robbins founded the Anthony Robbins Foundation,[34] intended to help young, homeless, elderly, prisoners, adults, and imprisonment. [37] The non-primary sources] In 2014, he donated the profits of his book, *Money: Master of the Game*, along with an additional personal donation, to Food America to the people in need. [38]. [39] [40] Robbins also donated profit from unsolved: *Your Financial Freedom America Playbook*. [41] Robbins works with a water company called Spring Health, which provides fresh water to small villages in rural India areas to prevent waterborne diseases. [42] Robbins helped raise money for Operation Underground Railroad, a nonprofit organization that fought against child trafficking and slavery and assistance from former CIA, SEALs Army, and special operatifts. [43] Legal Issues and Conflicts 1995 Consumer Settlement with the Federal Trade Commission in May 1995, Robbins International Research (R.R.I.) resolved with the Federal Trade Commission over violations of the agency's franchise violation. According to the settlement, R.I. I. didn't admit that it violated the law but agreed to pay \$221,260 in consumer pleasures. [47] [48] 2001 Vancouver Sun's trial for libeling in 2001, the British Columbia Supreme rule that the Vancouver Sun had broadcast Robbins by calling him an untrue, wife-stealing hypocrite. The court gave Robbins \$20,000 damages and his legal costs. [49] [50] 2012 and 2016 fire-walking injury in July 2012, the San Jose Mercury News published a story that reported several people were burned and hospitalized during one of robbins' fire-market events on July 19, 2012. This story was picked up by other media outlets, including the Fox News, New York Times, and CNN. [51] [52] These reports were later retracted as incorrect. [53] A corrective article was published by the Huffington Post. [54] [55] On June 24, 2016, it was reported that dozens were burned and demanded medical attention after attempting to walk over hot coal during a fire-walking event at a Tony Robbins seminar in Dallas, Texas. [56] Several participants were transported to medical facilities to treat burns, and a bus was used as a staging area for between 30 and 40 people who were less seriously injured. [56] A spokesman for the Robbin organization stated, A person familiar with the process of the fire-market called 911 reporting the need for emergency service vehicles [...] there was no need for emergency personnel [...] only 5 of 7,000 participants requested an examination beyond what was easily available on site. [57] 2019 Sexual harassment and abuse allegations in May 2019, an investigation by BuzzFeed News detailed allegations against Robbins of his sexual harassment of fans and harassing, like groping fans at events, exposing his genitals to his assistants, and sexually harassing fans. [58] As of that time, nine women have publicly accused Robbins of sexual misdemeanor. [60] Robbins denied the allegations and also stated, I was the target of a year-long investigation by BuzzFeed. Unfortunately, your organization has made it clear to my team that you intend to advance and publish an incorrect, agenda-driven version of the past, pierced and lies. [61] In November 2019, BuzzFeed News published a six-part article accusing Robbins of molesting a girl during her time as a star speaker at SuperCamp, an elite camp in Southern California. articles claim events took place in 1985 when Robbins was 25, and that there were at least two witnesses. [62] Other media outlets also report on these allegations. [63] [64] [65] Robbins denied evil and began calling in Sue BuzzFeed News in Ireland. In response, BuzzFeed News said that stopping by their reports and suggesting that Robbins' decision to fill the summons in Ireland was an abuse of the Ireland court. [66] [67] [68] TV and Robbins films played camera roles in the Motes Reality films, *The Cable Guy*, [69] and the 2001 *Shallow Hal* film. [70] He also appeared in Roseanne's Show with a episode of *The Sopranos*. He plays himself in the 2010 film *Documentary Singularity* is near: *A True Story* about the future. In July 2010, NBC debuted *Breakthrough* and Tony Robbins, a reality show that followed Robbins as he helped participants of the show face their personal challenges. [72] [73] NBC canceled the show after lifting two of the planned six episodes due to low visership of 2.8million. [74] In March 2012, the CLEAN Network picked up the show for another season starting with the first season originally set re-run and after that led directly to the new 2012 season. [75] [76] In April 2012, Robbins began covering Oprah's life on the CLEAN network. [77] In 2015, filmmaker Joe Berlinger directed and produced documenting the Tony Robbins: I'm not Guru You, about the event Tony Robbins Dat and Destiny after completing it in Boca Raton, Florida, in December 2014. He was the southwestern premier of the Film Festival in March 2016[79] and opened the American Documented Army Festival (AmDocs) in Spring Palm in February 2016. [80] The documentary was translated into language for 190 countries and released by Netflix on 15 July 2016. [81] In 1984, Robbins married Rebecca Becky Jenkins after meeting her at a seminar. [82] [83] [84] Jenkins had three children from two former marriages, people Robbins adopted. Robbins and Jenkins filed for divorce in 1998. [84] In 1984, Robbins was the father of a child with former girlfriend Liz Acosta. The son, Jairek Robbins, is also a personal opportunity coach.
