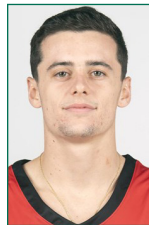

NESCAC Player of the Week



Sam Peek | Wesleyan

Senior, Guard, Poughkeepsie, N.Y.

Peek scored 25 points in consecutive games last week while averaging 8.5 rebounds and 1.5 blocks and shooting 51.4 percent from the floor. Peek scored 25 points in a win over Manhattanville that included nine rebounds as he shot 11-for-17 (64.7%) from the floor and went 3-of-7 from 3-point range. He followed up with another 25 point-effort with eight rebounds, two blocks, and two steals in a win at Farmingdale State. The Cardinals close out the fall semester with a 9-1 record.

NESCAC Notes

Amherst - Senior **Grant Robinson** (Chevy Chase, Md.) scored 17 points with four rebounds and three assists in the Mammoths' 75-61 win at Springfield. He went 3-of-3 from the free-throw line and is 7-of-7 from the line this season for the undefeated Mammoths...**Bates** - First-year **Drew Sachs** (Ann Arbor, Mich.) helped the Bobcats go 2-0 last week. He scored 10 points on 4-of-5 shooting in an 80-74 win over rival Bowdoin on Saturday. He tallied a game-high 23 points on 8-for-13 shooting on Monday in an 82-80 win at Husson. Sachs made 6-of-9 3-pointers, knocking down five shots from beyond the arc in the second half as Bates came from behind to beat the Eagles. Overall, Sachs shot 66.6 percent from the floor and 72.7 percent from 3-point range for the week...**Bowdoin** - **Xander Werkman** (Spokane, Wash.) hit two free throws with under four seconds remaining to give the Bowdoin men's basketball team a one-point win over Husson on Wednesday. The game-winning points capped a 19-point, seven-rebound effort...**Colby** - Junior **Will King** (Glenview, Ill.) averaged 15.5 points, 7.0 rebounds, and 5.5 assists over two close games last week. In an overtime victory versus Maine-Farmington, King scored nine points in the extra frame with two 3-pointers and three free throws to help the Mules pull away from the Beavers...**Connecticut College** - ...**Hamilton** - In the Continentals' lone game first-year **Hank Morgan** (Caldwell, N.J.) scored a team and season-high 14 points and grabbed six rebounds, including five on the offensive glass, in an 84-61 win over Purchase College...**Middlebury** - Junior **Alex Sobel** (Setauket, N.Y.) led Middlebury to an 82-61 victory at Plattsburgh State, extending the Panthers' win streak to six. He recorded his seventh double-double of the season with 22 points and 15 rebounds. He had four blocks of the game to move him into seventh on the Panther's all-time list with 110 in his career...**Trinity** - Senior **Donald Jorden** (Tampa, Fla.) had 19 points, 17 rebounds, two steals, and a blocked shot in an 85-82 loss at Nichols. He also had a team-high 18 points, five boards, and a steal in an 87-56 victory over CCNY. Jorden made 12-of-19 shots from the floor and all 13 of his free throws in the two games...**Tufts** - Senior **Tyler Aronson's** (Holliston, Mass.) 22 points against Nichols was the second-highest scoring total of his career. He had 13 points in the first half as Tufts built a six-point advantage. Aronson added nine rebounds and two assists as well...**Williams** - First-year **Declan Porter** (Canton, N.Y.) poured in a career-high 24 points on 9-of-15 shooting (6-of-12 3FG) in a 74-61 win over Springfield. Williams went 2-0 last week with Porter averaging 17.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 2.5 assists per game.
