Matt Gellerman | Hamilton

Sophomore, Forward, Inver Grove Heights, Minn.

In the Continentals' lone game, Gellerman had a hand in three of Hamilton's goals in a 4-1 win at Williams. He scored a power-play goal midway through the first period, had an assist on the goal that made it 2-0 early in the second period and scored an unassisted goal for a 4-0 lead late in the second period. The multi-point game was the first of his career.

Amherst - Sophomore **Quinton Fox** (Fonthill, Ontario) scored his first collegiate goal to spark a Mammoths' comeback effort in a 3-2 overtime loss at Williams on Sunday...**Bowdoin** - Chris Brown (Worcester, Mass.) scored the overtime game-winner as the Polar Bears rallied from a two-goal deficit to defeat Tufts, 3-2, on Saturday....**Colby** - Sophomore **Jack Sullivan** (Elmhurst, Ill.) spearheaded a Mules defense that allowed three shots on goal in the first period and 13 in the game, in a 4-0 win at Tufts. The defenseman also assisted the first two goals in the first period...**Connecticut College** - Connecticut College fell to Salem State on the road, 3-1, in its only game last week. Senior **Anthony Quatieri** (Peabody, Mass.) scored the lone goal, and classmate **Mike McHale** (Needham, Mass.) made 16 saves in net...**Middlebury** - The Panthers were idle last week...**Trinity** - Sophomore **Devan Tongue** (Hampden, Mass.) had a goal and an assist in Trinity's 4-3 victory over Hobart. He scored Trinity's first goal of the game on a power play to tie the game at 1-1 and had an assist on the game-winner...**Tufts** - With his power-play goal against Bowdoin in the first period on Saturday, senior **Angus Scott** (Salt Lake City, Utah) has a team-high five goals, matching his career total entering the 2021-22 season...**Wesleyan** - Junior **Emmet Powell** (Marcellus, N.Y.) scored the game-winner to seal a last-minute comeback that saw the Cardinals score twice in 56 seconds with under three minutes to play, erasing a 2-1 deficit and defeat Plymouth State, 3-2. Powell scored with exactly two minutes left for his team-leading fourth goal of the season...**Williams** - Senior forward **Jack Forrest** (Ridgefield, Conn.) scored the game-winning goal with 1:07 left in overtime to lift the Ephs to a 3-2 victory over Amherst. Forrest has two goals and one assist through three games this season.
