### NESCAC Player of the Week



#### Molly Ryan | Tufts Senior, Guard, Westfield, N.J.

Ryan led Tufts to wins over WPI and MIT averaging 20.5 points and 2.5 steals per game for the week. She scored 13 of her 20 points in the first half to help Tufts build a 45-30 halftime advantage and hand WPI its first loss of the year. Ryan scored 21 points, including 12 in the second half, as Tufts erased a halftime deficit and pulled away from MIT for the victory.

### NESCAC Notes

**Amherst** - The Mammoths were idle last week...**Bates** - Junior **Meghan Graff** (South Portland, Maine) tallied a game-high 22 points on 10-of-19 shooting to lead Bates to a 65-48 win at Husson on Monday. She dished out a game-high six assists, pulled down five rebounds, and recorded three steals to help the Bobcats win their fifth straight game...**Bowdoin** - First-year **Sydney Jones** (Chestnut Hill, Mass.) led the Polar Bears to a 69-43 non-conference win at Maine-Farmington with 19 points, eight rebounds, and four steals...**Colby** - Senior **Keagan Dunbar** (Middlebury, Vt.) averaged 14.0 points, 4.5 rebounds, and 2.5 assists in two wins last week. She was the leading scorer for the Mules in both games. Colby is 8-1 for the first time since 2014-15...**Connecticut College** - ...**Hamilton** - The Continentals were idle last week...**Middlebury** - First-year **Alexa Mustafaj** (Yonkers, N.Y.) led Middlebury to an 81-60 triumph at Plattsburgh State. She eclipsed the 20-point mark for the fifth time this season with 24 points while grabbing seven boards. Mustafaj leads the team averaging 20.8 points per game while ranking second in the NESCAC in field goal percentage (54.5%)...**Trinity** - Junior **Samantha Gallo** (Northford, Conn.) averaged 18.3 points, 8.7 rebounds, and 1.7 steals per game in a 3-0 week for the Bantams. She shot 68.9 percent (20-for-29) from the field and went 15-for-18 from the foul line for the week. She scored 17 points and grabbed six rebounds in a 74-58 win against Fisher, added 14 points and 10 rebounds in a 49-44 win over Union, and tallied 24 points, 10 boards, and three steals in an 87-59 win over Gordon. Gallo made all nine of her shots from the field and all six free throws in the first three quarters versus the Fighting Scots...**Wesleyan** - Senior guard **Marina Petruzzi** (Clairton, Pa.) scored a season-high 19 points on 7-of-15 shooting (4-of-8 from 3-point range) to go along with six rebounds in a loss at Williams...**Williams** - Junior **Maddy Mandyck** (West Hartford, Conn.) averaged 17.5 points and 10.5 rebounds per game while shooting 64 percent (16-for-25) from the floor in a 1-1 week for the Ephs. In a 65-60 loss at Smith, she went 10-for-14 from the floor and finished with 23 points and seven rebounds. In a Little Three win over Wesleyan, she netted 12 points with 14 rebounds and six assists. She turned the ball over just one time in 79 minutes on the court.
