### NESCAC Player of the Week



#### Tracey Stafford | Hamilton

#### Senior, Forward, Ridgefield, Conn.

Stafford put Hamilton on the board in a 3-1 win against Colby before adding an insurance goal. The senior also tallied the Continentals' eventual game-winning goal in a 3-0 victory against Bates. Stafford leads the team with seven goals and 15 points.

### NESCAC Notes

**Amherst** - Muffie Mazambani (Harare, Zimbabwe) had one goal in each game last week as the Mammoths ran their win streak to seven with three NESCAC wins over Conn. College, Bowdoin, and Wesleyan. The win over Wesleyan secured the 2022 Little Three Championship for the Mammoths. Mazambani was credited with the game-winning goal against Wesleyan, and put the Mammoths up 1-0 in their win over Bowdoin. The junior has scored in four consecutive games and leads the team with 10 goals this season...**Bates** - Paige Cote (Auburn, Maine) was involved in five of the six goals scored over the last week by Bates. The junior scored a goal and dished out two assists in a 3-0 win over the University of New England. Cote tallied two more assists in a 3-2 win over Wesleyan...**Bowdoin** - Senior Georgie Coetzer (Johannesburg, South Africa) scored the game's lone goal with six minutes remaining in a 1-0 win at Trinity on Saturday. The Polar Bear defender also recorded a pair of defensive saves in the shutout...**Colby** - Pernilla Shaw (Bow, N.H.) scored Colby's first goal in a midweek victory over cross-town rival Thomas. On Saturday, the sophomore scored her fourth goal of the season, tallying the Mules' lone goal against Middlebury...**Connecticut College** - Sophie Moniz (Alexandria, Va.) played every minute in goal during the Camels' three conference games last week. The sophomore finished with a combined 26 saves, including a season-high 10 against Williams...**Middlebury** - Sophomore Amy Griffin (Wilmette, Ill.) tallied a hat trick in a 10-1 victory over Connecticut College on Saturday. This marked the second straight game that Griffin scored three goals in. She accumulated nine points (4G, 1A) in a NESCAC weekend sweep, helping Middlebury record its 50th-straight victory on Peter Kohn Field and its 41st consecutive win. Griffin continues leading the conference in points (34) and is first with eight assists and second with her 13 tallies...**Trinity** - Junior Olivia McMichael (Glenside, Pa.) made five saves in a 1-0 loss against Bowdoin...**Tufts** - Reegan McCluskey (Los Gatos, Calif.) scored on a penalty stroke to tie the game at 1-1 in Tufts' eventual 2-1 loss at Endicott on Thursday evening. The senior leads the Jumbos with six goals this fall...**Wesleyan** - Diana Schwarz (Etna, N.H.) scored twice in a 3-2, home loss to Bates on Sunday and added an assist in Wednesday's 3-2 OT win at Roger Williams as the senior posted five points in the three games over the week for the Cardinals...**Williams** - Emily Batchelor (Sherborn, Mass.) scored a hat trick in the Ephs' 7-0 win over Connecticut College Saturday. The senior also finished with two goals and one assist in a 6-0 win over visiting Skidmore on Thursday.

### NESCAC Player of the Week



#### Charles Hawthorn | Hamilton Sophomore, Forward, Houston, Texas

Hawthorn registered seven points (3 goals, 1 assist) in three matches for the Continentals. Hawthorn had a hand in all three conference goals scored over the weekend as the forward posted a goal and an assist in a 2-2 tie with Bates, and notched the game-tying goal in the 82nd minute of a 1-1 draw with Colby to remain atop the NESCAC standings. The forward added another goal in a 5-0 victory against Utica.

### NESCAC Notes

**Amherst - Fynn Hayton-Ruffner** (Albany, Calif.) had two goals for four points in a 2-0-1 week for the Mammoths. The sophomore scored the game-winning goal in both victories, tallying a goal in the 57th minute of a 1-0 win over WPI and then opened scoring in a 2-0 win over Wesleyan in the ninth minute. The forward leads Amherst with 19 points this season (7 goals, 5 assists)...

**Bates - Rawson Welch** (Denver, Colo.) scored with just 39 seconds remaining at Hamilton as Bobcats escaped with 2-2 tie. The junior once again demonstrated a flair for the dramatic Sunday at Wesleyan with a goal in the 66th minute to put Bates ahead, 4-3, after trailing 3-0 at halftime. The teams played to a 4-4 draw...

**Bowdoin** - Senior goaltender **Michael Webber** (Natick, Mass.) posted three consecutive road shutouts last week for the Polar Bears, including a pair in league contests, leading his team to a 2-0-1 mark. He capped the week with four saves in a 0-0 draw at Amherst, including a key stop with under a minute to play to preserve the tie. He is currently on a 402:19 shutout streak and leads the NESCAC by a wide margin with a 0.37 goals against average this year...

**Colby - Aidan O'Brien** (Farmington, Conn.) scored his first two goals of the season in a 1-1-1 week for the Mules. On Tuesday, the senior scored the first goal in a 2-0 win over the University of New England. #### Sophia Lindus | Wesleyan

#### First Year, Outside Hitter, Los Angeles, Calif.

Lindus helped secure the Cardinals' fourth Little Three title in the past five seasons after recording 36 kills (5.14/set) and hitting .383 for the week. She led the team with 43 service receptions, committing just one error in those attempts, while notching 31 digs in both matches (4.43/set).
