NESCAC Player of the Week

Sam Peek | Wesleyan Senior, Guard, Poughkeepsie, N.Y.

Peek averaged 27.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 3.0 assists in two games while shooting 68.6 percent from the floor. Peek registered his second career 30-point game as he went 14-of-19 from the floor in a win over Colby. He followed up shooting 10-for-16 from the floor to score 24 points in a 101-65 home win over Bowdoin. Wesleyan reached the 100-point plateau for just the second time against a NESCAC opponent in program history, with the first time coming in a win over Middlebury in 2003.

NESCAC Notes

Amherst - Senior Tim McCarthy (Medfield, Mass.) averaged 13 points per game last week for the Mammoths. In a 71-65 loss at Connecticut College, he posted team-highs of 19 points and six rebounds to go with two assists...Bates - First-year Jahmir Primer (Hempstead, N.Y.) averaged 19.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game in a 1-2 week for the Bobcats. He poured in 20 points on Monday against UMaine-Farmington to help head coach Jon Furbush '05 become the winningest coach in program history. Primer followed up with 13 points against Middlebury and a careerhigh 25 points on 9-for-18 shooting against Williams...Bowdoin - First-year James McGowan (Westwood, Mass.) had 18 points, seven rebounds, and four assists in a mid-week setback to Maine-Farmington...Colby - Sophomore Lucas Green (Franklin Park, N.J.) scored a career-high 19 points against Tufts. In the two NESCAC matchups last week, where he earned his fourth and fifth starts of the season, Green averaged 12.0 points, 2.5 rebounds, and 4.0 assists per game... Connecticut College - Sophomore Jarron Flynn (Roslindale, Mass.) averaged 14.0 points and 4.0 steals in two NESCAC wins last week. He netted a game-high 20 points in 27 minutes and collected four steals in a victory over Hamilton. Flynn added eight points and four steals in a win over Amherst... Hamilton - Junior Conner Rood (Austin, Texas) handed out three assists in both games at Connecticut College and Trinity and grabbed nine rebounds against the Bantams. He ranks third in the NESCAC with 3.6 assists per game...Middlebury - Junior Alex Sobel (Setauket, N.Y.) recorded back-to-back double-doubles last weekend and has 16 this season. Sobel led all players in scoring with 20 points while pulling down 11 rebounds to lead Middlebury past Bates 69-52. In a close loss at Tufts, he tallied 12 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. His 269 boards moved him into fourth on the Panthers' single-season list. Sobel finishes the regular season leading the NESCAC averaging 12.2 rebounds and 3.5 blocks per game while ranking third with 18.2 points per contest...Trinity - Senior Donald Jorden, Jr. (Tampa, Fla.) led the Bantams to a weekend sweep against Amherst and Hamilton, averaging 13.5 points, 9.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists, and 2.0 blocks per game. In a 62-53 win over the Mammoths, Jorden had 15 points, seven rebounds, and a block. In a 51-32 victory over the Continentals, Jorden notched 12 points, 11 boards, and three blocked shots... Tufts - Junior Dylan Thoerner (Irvine, Calif.) averaged 17.3 points per game while shooting 53.1 percent from the field, 46.7 percent from 3-point range, and 84.6 percent from the line in wins over Colby, Williams, and Middlebury. Against Middlebury, his four points in the final three minutes helped Tufts turn a 68-68 tie into an 81-73 win. Against the Ephs, his 13 first-half points helped Tufts build a 14-point halftime lead. He also added a clutch 3-pointer as Tufts pulled away from Colby in the second half after the Mules had tied the game.
