NESCAC Player of the Week



Mia Roy | Bates

Senior, Guard, Bedford, N.H.

Roy broke the NESCAC Championships record for points in one game with a career-high 35 at Middlebury on Saturday. Roy shot 12-for-22 from the floor and knocked down 5-of-7 from 3-point range. She also dished out a career-high six assists in the 87-75 win for the Bobcats. Bates advances to the NESCAC Semifinals for the first time since 2010.

NESCAC Notes

Amherst - Senior **Dani Valdez** (Poughkeepsie, N.Y.) averaged 17.0 points and 9.5 rebounds per game in a 2-0 week for the Mammoths. In a NESCAC Quarterfinal win over Colby, she netted 15 points with eight rebounds, two steals, and one assist. In a win over Jersey City, she posted 19 points and 11 rebounds for her sixth double-double of the season...**Bowdoin** - Sophomore **Callie Godfrey** (Cheshire, Conn.) led a hard-fought effort for a shorthanded Polar Bear team in the NESCAC First Round, scoring 13 points with seven rebounds in a loss to No. 11 Colby...**Colby** - Senior **Chiamaka Ubani** (Elmont, N.Y.) led the Mules to their first win over Bowdoin since 2010 and the team's first NESCAC postseason win since 2016-17. She posted her second double-double of the season with 10 point and a career-high 13 rebounds to lead four Mules in double-figures. In the NESCAC Quarterfinals at No. 3 Amherst, Ubani netted 12 points and two steals. She leads the NESCAC in steals at 2.3 per game...**Hamilton** - Sophomore **Emily Hall** (Phoenix, N.Y.) recorded her first double-double with 13 points and a season-high 10 rebounds in a NESCAC Quarterfinal loss at Wesleyan. She tied a season-best with five assists and added three steals...**Middlebury** - First-year **Alexa Mustafaj** (Yonkers, N.Y.) led Middlebury with 27 points in a NESCAC Quarterfinal contest versus Bates. She went 5-for-5 at the charity stripe and shot 52 percent from the floor. She finished the regular season leading the NESCAC in scoring (20.7 ppg)...**Trinity** - Sophomore **Reilly Campbell** (Wallingford, Conn.) had 16 points, nine rebounds, three steals, and two blocks in a 57-46 win over No. 8 Williams in the NESCAC Quarterfinals. Campbell made 7-of-12 shots from the field and scored 10 of her points in the second half when the Bantams outscored the Ephs, 35-21...**Tufts** - Sophomore **Maggie Russell** (Morristown, N.J.) led Tufts with 22 points as the Jumbos held off No. 7 Wesleyan in the NESCAC Quarterfinals. She had eight first-quarter points as the Jumbos established an early lead. With Tufts clinging to a fourth-quarter lead, she had a basket that put Tufts up by five halfway through the period, then hit two free throws with 10 seconds left to provide the final margin of victory...**Wesleyan** - Leading the Cardinals with averages of 16.0 points and 8.0 rebounds per game was senior **Caleigh Ryan** (New York, N.Y.). She recorded nine points, 10 rebounds, and three assists in a NESCAC First Round win over No. 10 Hamilton at home on Friday. Ryan followed with 23 points on 5-of-9 shooting from three, to go along with six rebounds in a 58-55 NESCAC Quarterfinal loss at No. 2 Tufts...**Williams** - Junior **Maddy Mandyck** (West Hartford, Conn.) had 12 points, 10 rebounds, four steals, and two blocks in a 40-31 win over No. 9 Connecticut College in a NESCAC First Round game. At top-seeded Trinity in the NESCAC Quarterfinals, she scored 15 points, snared eight rebounds, had two steals, and blocked two shots in a 56-47 loss.
