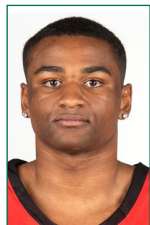

NESCAC Co-Players of the Week



Garrett Day | Amherst Senior, Guard, Pittsburgh, Pa

Day averaged 25.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per contest in a 2-0 week for the Mammoths, who posted wins over Colby and Bowdoin. Day also became the 31st Mammoth to surpass the 1,000-point milestone at Amherst. He shot 44.0 percent (12-of-27) from 3-point range in the two wins. He netted a team-high 24 points with eight rebounds in a 68-56 win over Bowdoin and scored a team-high 27 points in a 74-60 win over Colby.



Jordan James | Wesleyan Senior, Forward, Vienna, Va.

In an 83-67 win at Middlebury, James scored a game-high 23 points on 11-for-17 shooting with nine rebounds, three blocks, and four steals. He set new season highs in points, field goals, and steals while scoring 20-plus points for the fourth time in his career.

NESCAC Notes

Bates - Junior **Stephon Baxter** (Worcester, Mass.) scored 15 points, went 2-for-4 from 3-point range, dished out a game-high six assists, grabbed four rebounds, and recorded a game-high four steals in a 74-68 win over Connecticut College. He followed that up with a game-high 23 points on 11-for-24 shooting, five rebounds, four assists, and only one turnover against Trinity...**Bowdoin** - Senior **Taiga Kagitomi** (Tokyo, Japan) hit a spinning lay-up with 12 seconds remaining to give Bowdoin a 59-58 win over Hamilton on Saturday. He finished with a team-high 13 points in the win....**Colby** - Senior point guard **Matt Hanna** (Milford, Mass.) reached double-digit points in each of his three contests last week. On Tuesday, he scored 22 points with six rebounds and five assists in a victory at Trinity. On Saturday, Hanna tallied his second double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 rebounds at Amherst...**Hamilton** - Senior **Nick Osarenren** (Lynnfield, Mass.) averaged 13.0 points, 6.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists, 2.5 steals, and 2.0 blocked shots in two games. He posted 12 points, seven boards, four assists, two steals, and two blocks in a 66-54 win against Colby. He paced the Continentals with 14 points, three steals, and two blocks in a one-point setback against Bowdoin...**Middlebury** - Junior **Alex Sobel** (Setauket, N.Y.) and sophomore **Noah Osher** (Northbrook, Ill.) both tallied 18 points to pace Middlebury in a loss to Wesleyan. Sobel also had four blocks and a team-high eight rebounds...**Trinity** - Senior **Donald Jorden, Jr.** (Tampa, Fla.) scored 16 points and grabbed nine rebounds in a 70-66 win at Bates. He also scored 20 points with 10 boards and three steals in a 76-69 loss to Colby and added eight points, 12 rebounds, two assists, two blocks, and two steals in a 61-38 setback at Tufts...**Tufts** - In balanced team performances in wins against Trinity and Connecticut College, senior **Luke Rogers** (Boxborough, Mass.) averaged 14.5 points and 10.5 rebounds per game while shooting 53.0 percent from the field. He posted two double-doubles with 11 points and 10 rebounds against Trinity and 18 points with 11 rebounds versus Connecticut College. He helped the Tufts defense allow just 11 first-half points against the Bantams...**Williams** - The Ephs were idle last week.
