NESCAC Player of the Week



Marc Smith | Wesleyan

Sophomore, Goalie, Hanover, Mass.

Smith recorded his first career shutout, making 24 saves in a 3-0 win at Williams. Smith became the first Cardinal goal since 2013 to record a shutout against the Ephs on the road. He followed that up with a career-high 30 saves in a 5-2 win at Middlebury. Smith is now sporting a 1.25 goals against average and .953 save percentage in the Cardinals' current four-game win streak.

NESCAC Notes

Amherst - First-year **Matt Toporowski** (Kirkland, Quebec) had a hand in three of the six Mammoth goals last week, garnering two assists in a 5-3 win at Bowdoin, including the game-winning goal, and setting up the game's only goal in a 1-0 win at Colby Sunday...**Bowdoin** - Junior **Chris Brown** (Worcester, Mass.) scored the game-tying goal in the third period for Bowdoin in an eventual overtime loss to Hamilton on Friday...**Colby** - In overtime against Hamilton, sophomore **John McElaney** (Walpole, Mass.) served the puck back on his own net where goalie **Andy Beran** (St. Paul, Minn.) delivered the puck back to McElaney on the move, who took it back up the ice for the game-winning goal...**Connecticut College** - In a home-and-home series with Tufts, senior **Paul Capozzi** (Lake Forest, Ill.) had an assist in a 3-2 loss at Tufts and gave the Camels a 1-0 lead in the third period in an eventual 2-2 tie at home against the Jumbos...**Hamilton** - Senior **Sean Storr** (Kingston, Ontario) made 27 saves in a 2-1 overtime win at Bowdoin and turned away a season-high 33 shots in a 3-2 overtime setback at Colby...**Middlebury** - Sophomore **Paddy Bogart** (Newburyport, Mass.) factored into three of Middlebury's four goals in a pair of NESCAC contests last week. He tallied the go-ahead goal in a 2-2 tie with Trinity on a power play. Against Wesleyan, Bogart assisted the first Panther goal and then cut the deficit to one (3-2) with another power-play marker...**Trinity** - Sophomore **Devan Tongue** (Hampden, Mass.) scored a goal in a 2-2 tie at Middlebury and assisted on another tally in Trinity's 3-2 victory at Williams...**Tufts** - The Jumbos took the weekend series over Connecticut College with a 3-2 win on Friday and a 2-2 tie on Saturday. First-year **Brennan Horn** (Hartford, Conn.) had points in both games. He scored the eventual game-winning goal on Friday night, then assisted on Tufts' first goal Saturday when the Jumbos came back from down 2-0 in the third period to tie the game.
