NESCAC Player of the Week



Bailey Hyland | Trinity

Senior, Guard, Broad Brook, Conn.

Hyland averaged 11.6 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.6 assists, and 1.6 steals per game in three NESCAC wins for the Bantams. She had 12 points, eight rebounds, and three assists in a 62-59 win over Middlebury. In a 60-42 victory over Tufts, Hyland contributed 14 points with six rebounds, and she added nine points, seven rebounds, and five assists in a 64-59 win against Bates...

NESCAC Notes

Amherst - First-year **AnLing Vera** (Cerritos, Calif.) averaged 12.6 points and 4.6 assists per game a 3-0 week for the Mammoths. She scored a career-high 26 points in a 72-54 win at Bowdoin on Sunday...**Bates** - Junior captain **Meghan Graff** (South Portland, Maine) became the 21st Bobcat to reach the 1,000-point milestone after scoring a game-high 29 points against Trinity. Graff shot 12-for-22 from the field and dished out four assists in the contest...**Bowdoin** - Junior **Sela Kay** (Los Angeles, Calif.) scored 29 points, tying her own school record with seven three-pointers, in a win over Hamilton on Friday. She added 25 more against Amherst on Saturday. **Connecticut College** - Junior **Jaycie Rojik** (Scituate, Mass.) scored a team-high 19 points, grabbed six rebounds, dished out four assists, and collected four steals in a 63-50 victory over Bates...**Colby** - Sophomore guard **Caroline Smith** (Freeport, Maine) posted double-digits in each contest last week. She opened the weekend with 10 points and eight rebounds against Hamilton and followed up with 15 points and five boards against Amherst. Smith also collected two steals in each game...**Hamilton** - Senior **Claire Sehring** (Sauquoit, N.Y.) scored a career-high 22 points and added eight rebounds and three steals in a 59-55 win at Colby. She tallied 11 points in the fourth quarter alone as the Continentals turned a six-point deficit at 49-43 into a 56-51 lead with 3:16 left...**Middlebury** - First-year **Alexa Mustafaj** (Yonkers, N.Y.) led Middlebury in a 1-1 NESCAC week, averaging 20.5 points, 3.5 steals, and 4.5 rebounds per game. Mustafaj leads the conference in scoring (19.9 ppg) and steals (2.4 spg)...**Tufts** - In a three-game week for Tufts, senior **Sofia Rosa** (Sudbury, Mass.) averaged 14.3 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 3.0 assists per game while shooting 69.2 from the field. Tufts overcame Smith in the fourth quarter led by Rosa's six points. Against Connecticut College, she shot 7-for-8 from the field overall...**Wesleyan** - Senior **Caleigh Ryan** (New York, N.Y.) posted two double-doubles and averaged 15.5 points, 14.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 3.0 steals, and 2.0 blocks per game. In a win over Williams, she recorded 13 points, 15 rebounds, two assists, three blocks, and three steals. She followed that up with 18 points, 13 rebounds, two assists, and three steals against Middlebury...**Williams** - Junior **Maddie Mandyck** (West Hartford, Conn.) hauled in 17 rebounds and had eight blocks in a 53-50 win at Mitchell. She also collected 13 rebounds in a loss to Wesleyan and finished the week with 30 rebounds in two games.
