NESCAC Player of the Week



Gabe Ravetz | Wesleyan

Senior, Guard, New York, N.Y.

Ravetz went 8-for-14 (57.1%) from 3-point range last week for the Cardinals. The senior opened the week with 14 points in 19 minutes a win over Mitchell and followed up by matching his career-high with 23 points, including 16 points in the first half, as he hit his first six attempts from 3-point range (6-for-10 overall) in a 69-64 home win over Conn. College.

NESCAC Notes

Amherst - In an overtime win at Bates, junior **Mohammed Alausa** (Chicago, Ill.) scored a season-high 19 points behind a 6-for-6 effort from 3-point range... **Bates** - **Steph Baxter** (Worcester, Mass.) scored a game-high 23 points against Hamilton on Friday and a game-high 27 points against Amherst on Saturday. Baxter shot 9-of-18 from the field against the Continentals, grabbed four rebounds, dished out three assists, and recorded three steals. Baxter scored 24 of his 27 points against the Mammoths in the second half as the Bobcats rallied from 16 points down to force overtime. The senior made 4-of-6 from 3-point range and grabbed four rebounds, tallied four assists, and recorded three steals against the Mammoths. Baxter is averaging 23.7 points per game in NESCAC play, tops in the conference...

Bowdoin - Sophomore **James McGowan** (Westwood, Mass.) had 23 points and seven rebounds in a loss to Williams... **Colby** - **Max Poulton** (Wellesley, Mass.) averaged 19.0 points per game over two contests last week. The first-year's 27 points against Williams on Friday marked a season-high. Poulton has posted 11 double-digit scoring performances on the year... **Connecticut College** - **Cam Schainfeld** (Newton, Mass.) averaged 11.0 points and 4.5 assists per game last week as the Camels went 1-1 in league action. The junior netted a game-high 13 points in a 58-52 win over Trinity, leading Conn. College to its first 3-0 start against NESCAC competition since the 1998-99 season... **Hamilton**

- **Eric Anderson** (Santa Barbara, Calif.) posted 16 points and 10 rebounds in a 67-64 win at Bates. The senior has two double-doubles this season and four in his career. Anderson dropped in a career-high 22 points and grabbed seven boards in a 57-54 setback at Tufts... **Middlebury** - **Alex Sobel** (Setauket, N.Y.) propelled Middlebury to a pair of key NESCAC victories last weekend. The senior eclipsed the 1,000 career-point mark with 12 points in an 80-60 win over Bowdoin. Sobel also grabbed eight boards and four blocks against the Polar Bears. The forward followed up with 15 points, eight rebounds, and a career-best tying seven blocks in a 72-63 triumph over Colby. Sobel has blocked seven shots in a game three times this season and ranks second in the country in total blocks (65) and blocks per game (4.33)... **Trinity** - Senior **C.J. Redd** (Peekskill, N.Y.) had 14 points, four rebounds, and two assists in an 80-59 win against Eastern Nazarene. He added 13 points and five boards in a 56-51 loss at Connecticut College... **Tufts** - **Tyler Aronson** (Holliston, Mass.) helped Tufts to three wins last week, including a pair of NESCAC victories over Amherst and Hamilton. For the week, the senior averaged 13.3 points per game while adding 4.0 rebounds per contest. Aronson followed up an eight-point night at New England College with 13 points and six rebounds against Amherst and finished two points shy of his season-high with 19 points, shooting 6-of-12 while adding four steals and five boards versus Hamilton...

Williams - **Spencer Spivy** (San Francisco, Calif.) averaged 17.0 points and shot a combined 14-of-16 from the field during a 2-0 weekend for the Ephs. In a 79-70 win over Colby, Spivy scored a team-high 20 points, while shooting 8-for-9 from the field. The senior followed up with 14 points in a 79-64 triumph over Bowdoin Saturday.

NESCAC Player of the Week



Emma Sehring | Hamilton Senior, Forward, Sauquoit, N.Y.

Sehring nearly posted three double-doubles in a 2-1 week for the Continentals. The senior scored a career-high 20 points, including the game-tying bucket to force overtime with four seconds left in regulation, grabbed 15 rebounds, and blocked two shots in an 80-71 overtime win against Bates. Sehring added 11 points and nine boards in a 59-43 victory against Tufts as Hamilton ended its losing streak against the Jumbos at 16 games. The forward contributed 19 points and 13 rebounds in a 68-52 setback against Smith at the start of the week.

NESCAC Notes

Amherst - AnLing Vera (Cerritos, Calif.) averaged 17 points per game along with 3.0 assists and 2.7 rebounds per game in a 2-1 week for the Mammoths. The sophomore scored a season-high 25 points in a two-point loss to Tufts and scored 14 points in a 52-48 win over Bates the next day...**Bates** - Elsa Daulerio (Harpeswell, Maine) was efficient and productive on both ends of the court for the Bobcats in a pair of NESCAC contests last weekend. On Friday at Hamilton, Daulerio tallied 10 points, grabbed nine rebounds, dished out two assists, and blocked four shots. On Saturday against Amherst, Daulerio added six points and nine rebounds. The first-year also recorded a game-high three steals and blocked a shot against the Mammoths...**Bowdoin** - Rookie Emily Collins (Vernon, Conn.) had a career-high 14 points on 6-for-6 shooting from the field in a midweek win at Southern Maine...**Colby** - Lydia Mordarski (Mansfield, Mass.) averaged 15.5 points and 7.0 rebounds on the weekend. In Colby's upset victory over Middlebury, the first-year tallied all 16 points in the second half, accounting for 55 percent of the Mules scoring in the final 20 minutes...**Connecticut College** - Jaycie Rojik (Scituate, Mass.) averaged a team-high 14.0 points and 8.0 rebounds per game last week to lead the Camels. The senior netted a season-high 19 points and grabbed eight rebounds in a 56-51 loss to Trinity and contributed nine points and eight boards in a 56-43 setback against Wesleyan...**Middlebury** - Sophomore Alexa Mustafaj (Yonkers, N.Y.) helped lead Middlebury in an 84-68 victory at Bowdoin with a career-best 38 points and set a school record with a 16-for-16 effort from the charity stripe. Mustafaj, who added 18 points the following day in a setback to Colby, averaged 28.0 points per game for the week...**Trinity** - Senior Francesca Silva (Auburndale, Mass.) had 11 points, eight rebounds, and four assists in a 56-51 win against Connecticut College in the lone game of the week for the Bantams...**Tufts** - Junior Maggie Russell (Morristown, N.J.) averaged a double-double for the week at 10.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game the Jumbos went 1-1. Russell posted 14 points and 12 rebounds in a win at Amherst and posted six points, eight rebounds, and four steals at Hamilton...**Williams** - Maddy Mandyck (West Hartford, Conn.) averaged 17.5 points, 11.5 rebounds, and 4.5 blocks in a 2-0 weekend for the Ephs. Lachance extended his point streak to five games and has 10 total points in that five-game span. The defenseman racked up six points in three games last week, including one goal in a 5-2 win over Anna Maria. Lachance also matched his career-high with three points (1G, 2A) in a come-from-behind win over Bowdoin on Friday. Lachance closed out the week with a goal and assist for two points in a 3-3 tie against Colby where the Cardinals trailed 3-1 with under six minutes remaining.

First Year, Forward, Needham, Mass.

Nawrocki factored into half of Middlebury's goals in a 2-1 week with two goals and two assists. The forward began the week with the Panthers' lone goal in an overtime loss to Plattsburgh State. Nawrocki followed up with the game-winning tally in a 3-2 victory at Colby, while also assisting on the first goal of the game. On Saturday, Nawrocki assisted on the game-tying tally, which forced overtime, where the Panthers prevailed 4-3 over the Mules. The first-year leads Middlebury with eight goals this season.
