ARTICLE IX BIENNIAL CONVENTION

SECTION 1 Meetings

- A. The Biennial Convention of the MTFRW is to be held in the fall of the odd-numbered year at a time and location determined by the Executive Committee.
- B. The call will be issued by the MTFRW President at least 30 days prior to the convention.

SECTION 2 Voting Body

- A. Delegates from Units in good standing
 - 1. Two (2) delegates or alternates for the first twenty-five (25) members of major fraction thereof, and
 - 2. Two (2) delegates or alternates for each additional twenty-five (25) members or major fraction thereof
- B. Unit Presidents
- C. Members of the Board of Directors
- D. Each delegate or alternate is entitled to only one vote

SECTION 3 Quorum

A majority of the voting delegates registered, provided that delegates from at least one third (1/3) of the MTFRW Units in good standing are present.

SECTION 4 Proxies

A Unit President may appoint a member of her Unit, who is in good standing, as her proxy, with full voting power.
