EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING PERSONAL CARE SERVICES

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020, Governor Charlie Baker declared a state of emergency to respond to COVID-19;

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, Mayor Jon Mitchell declared a citywide state of emergency to respond to COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the continued provision of personal care services during the COVID-19 outbreak presents an imminent danger to public health;

NOW THEREFORE, Mayor Jon Mitchell and the New Bedford Board of Health ORDER that effective at 5:00 p.m. on March 20, 2020, all services offered to the public that cannot be provided at a distance of six (6) feet shall be discontinued. This ORDER includes, but is not limited to:

- Hairdressers and barbers
- Nail salons
- Massage services
- Body art
- Body work
- Aestheticians
- Day spas
- Tanning salons

This ORDER does NOT include services provided by a licensed allied health care provider, including, but not limited to, physical therapy, speech therapy, or occupational therapy.

This ORDER shall remain in effect until it is rescinded by the Mayor and the Board of Health.
