Since July of 2014 a movement of disciples making disciples has taken place in the northern region of Ghana. To date there are 802 different disciple groups among 45 different tribes totaling over 5,000 people. The 7 teams of disciple makers are each reaching into new segments of the northern region (after penetrating 2 full segments which now has section leaders and sub-section leaders) and into the neighboring country of Cote d'Ivoire, which now has over 89 groups, 685 people and a national leadership team prepared to continue the movement throughout Cote d'Ivoire and neighboring countries. They do this through operating a multi-faceted clinic, establishing and maturing Church plants, children's programs (feeding spiritually and physically), coffee farming, clothing outreach, hosting short term groups from abroad, and more.
