ASIA

Asian Children's Mission (ACM) promotes justice and Jesus for the women and children of Southeast Asia. Primarily working in Myanmar (Burma), Asian Children's Mission staffs primary and middle schools in villages that would otherwise have no schools, operates two children's homes, special needs schools and is involved in a wide variety of community development activities.

EUROPE

Latin American Ministries is located near Murcia, Spain. The region is rich in agriculture and fruit farms. Many Arabic-speaking Muslims from North Africa immigrate there each year to find jobs. LAM's ministry includes teaching Spanish to Arabic-speakers using Biblical texts. They also lead an international church that is attended by some Spaniards and many internationals.
