- Monroe County United Ministries provides affordable day care for families among the working poor in Monroe
 county. They also have a food pantry that serves low income families. Sherwood Oaks collects clothing, canned
 food and house cleaning items for MCUM.
- Boys & Girls Club reaches out to low income children with education and recreational activities that train children to be productive and responsible citizens. Sherwood Oaks partners with Boys & Girls Club be recruiting volunteers and donating to special projects. Tara Workman is our liaison with Boys & Girls Clubs.
- Salvation Army provides resources for under resourced families and individuals through a used clothing store and food pantry. Sherwood Oaks partners with SA to provide back packs for children at the beginning of school each year.
- **Habitat for Humanity** builds affordable housing for low income families who qualify with the agreement to establish a mortgage and pay-back plan for the new home. It's a hand up, not a hand out, to assist families to escape poverty. Sherwood Oaks is currently sponsoring a home for a local resident.
- **Community Kitchen** provides meals for the hungry and backpacks with food for children each weekend through the Backpack Buddies program. Sherwood Oaks collects dry goods and snacks for Backpack Buddies.
