A Short-term worker's God given gifts and talents will be utilized to serve Christian leaders who come to the **TCMI** campus near Vienna, Austria for ministry training. Jobs vary from house-and-grounds projects (mowing lawns, etc.) to food preparation and serving, setting tables, dusting, sweeping, changing bed linens, doing laundry, etc. A short-term worker **MUST** have a servant's heart to help the **Haus Edelweiss** staff give our guests the education and ministry they need.

Each short-term work trip to **Haus Edelweiss** is 13 days, including travel time. Short-term workers work 12 hours each day but with adequate breaks to rest. There are also many stairs to climb in the course of a day's work, so the volunteers must have good physical strength and stamina.

Each day begins with family devotions and a hearty breakfast before boarding vans for the work sites. Family teams of 25 work each day to build homes for needy Mexican families. Each year, families are deeply touched by the experience of working together, worshipping together, and growing together.

Fortunately there are those who are fighting hard against this social sickness. **RAPHA HOUSE** is a Christian relief group that provides 'safe houses' where girls who have been rescued from trafficking can be rehabilitated and restored.

This is a 'vision trip' designed to acquaint the team members with the realities of human trafficking, the Rapha House approach to creating new lives for their girls, and learn about the culture in Cambodia.

HAITIAN CHRISTIAN OUTREACH - HAITI

SEPTEMBER 21-28, 2019



Haitian Christian Outreach is reaching out to populations in the South West region of Haiti where there are limited medical and educational services. Through church planting, schools and a community hospital, they are meeting the spiritual, educational and physical needs of the communities in the south west regions. The HCO Peredo Community Hospital treats many patients and offers a new surgery unit that is the only such facility for many miles. Haitian doctors and nurses are joined by mission team medical staff to treat patients who would otherwise have little hope of proper treatment.

Project: This is the first **medical team** that Sherwood Oaks will send to assist in the mission hospital. Although a certain number of physicians, surgeons, and nurses are needed, non-medical team members are needed to help with intake, triage, prayer, and hospitality throughout the project. Cost: **\$2000 per person** covers all costs: road transportation, airfare, health insurance, food and lodging. Snacks and souvenirs are not covered.
