Icebreaker:

What is one lesson you were taught by an adult for which you are most grateful today?

Read: Deuteronomy 6:1-9; Mark 12:28-34

Discuss:

1. What doubts have you personally experienced about the Bible? How did you work through them?
2. The ZPC preacher usually says after reading the scripture, "This is the Word of the Lord. Thanks be to God." When you hear the Bible called the word of the Lord, how do you feel about that?
3. We say that God is revealed through the Bible. What are some things the Bible reveals about God? In the past seven weeks of this series, has God revealed something new to you?
4. The Ten Commandments are listed in Deuteronomy 5. How do you think those commands relate to loving God and loving neighbor?
5. Deuteronomy 6 says to impress God's commands on our children, and to talk about them often. Did someone pass down their faith to you? Have you been able to pass down faith to your children, or other covenant children?
6. Why do you think Jesus added the command loving your neighbor to loving God as the greatest commandment? What have you learned about loving your neighbor?
7. What is a reading plan or resource you could use to deepen your understanding of the Bible?
