# Home Groups | Week 6 | October 15, 2017 Acts | Reflecting Jesus to our world | Acts 6:1-7

#### Opener:

Last week, we asked you to think about and try to live radically for Christ in generosity, hospitality or honesty. How did that go?

#### Read and discuss:

- 1. This passage is about the early church dealing with conflict. In your own experience, how have you seen the church deal with conflict?
- 2. When conflict has occurred in your family, at work, or another group, how did you respond? The early church continued to grow after dealing with this conflict. How have you seen conflict strengthen a relationship, a family, or an organization?
- 3. Is waiting on tables or caring for widows less important than prayer and ministry of the word? Why or why not?
- 4. Consider other aspects of Christian life (such as prayer and study, or building community). Can you balance these aspects with Christian service and what is that like?
- 5. Why did the early leaders lay hands on and pray for these seven "deacons?" Have you ever been prayed for in such a meaningful way?

# **Activity:**

The first deacons waited on tables for widows. This week, make or serve dinner or do housework so that others can be at ease. How does this feel? How can this practice bring us closer to God?



# Family Promise | Interfaith Hospitality Network

ZPC has an opportunity to serve homeless children and their caregivers through Family Promise/Interfaith Hospitality Network (IHN), a national, faith-based, organization whose mission is to provide temporary, emergency shelter for homeless families. ZPC's next opportunity to host will be from November 26-December 3.



Each week up to fourteen homeless individuals are provided housing through a network of church

facilities. During the day, guests stay at a day center in downtown Indianapolis, where they receive social services. Older children attend school. Between 5 pm and 6 am, local congregations serve as hosts on a weekly rotational basis, providing lodging, meals, and hospitality.
