Icebreaker:

Growing up, were you ever told not to go to a certain neighborhood or to lock your car doors when you went? Where was that for you?

Questions:

- 1. Peter had a distinct vision from God. When have you heard most clearly from God or have seen God?
- 2. In Acts 10, Peter goes through several steps before he meets with Cornelius. What process do you go through when you have a difficult decision to make?
- 3. What is one area of your life where you feel God might be leading you but you are reluctant to follow or scared to follow?
- 4. In Acts 10:34-35, Peter said that God accepts all those who fear God and do what is right. Does this mean Cornelius's good deeds earn him salvation? Why or why not, in context of reading the rest of Peter's speech?
- 5. Peter says that God does not show favoritism and accepts people from every nation. This was revolutionary for a Jewish man to say and believe. How can we be revolutionary in our thinking and living so we don't show favoritism and accept people from all nations?
- 6. Peter (a Jewish Christian) shares the gospel with Cornelius (a Roman centurion and a Gentile). In your life, how much contact do you have with people from other ethnic groups or different backgrounds?
- 7. Why do many of our churches, including ZPC, struggle with integrating people from different races or ethnicities? What might we do differently?

Homework: Pray and consider how God is calling you to give of your time, talent and treasure in 2018.


