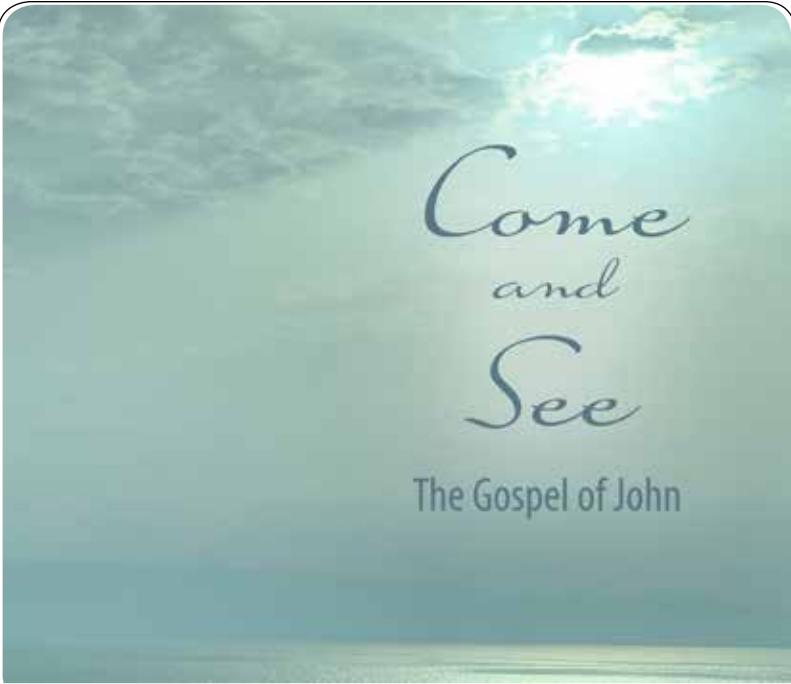

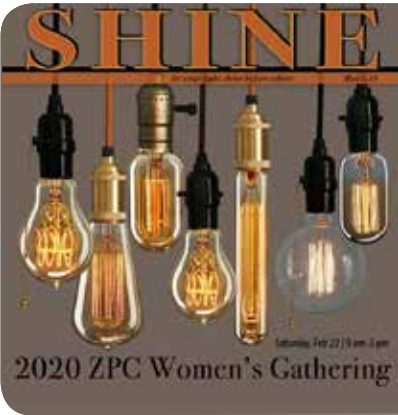

- Icebreaker:**
John the Baptist's (JTB) disciples may have been discussing/arguing about baptism in verse 25. What subjects do you avoid to keep from arguing (religion, money, politics, etc.)?
1. We see disciples following both JTB and Jesus. JTB was charismatic and fascinating (preaching repentance, eating locusts and honey) while Jesus was spectacular (turning water into wine). Do people today follow (or even worship) celebrities, sports stars or politicians? What is it that makes us want to follow (worship) others?
 2. John's disciples are probably comparing themselves to Jesus' disciples (verses 25-26). It's been said that living a life of comparison is crippling. In what ways do you compare yourself with others and how has that affected you?
 3. John the Baptist had a thriving ministry and now it seemed to his disciples that someone else's ministry was going to begin to thrive. This change was difficult for them (as it is for most of us). In what ways do you see ministry (at ZPC or elsewhere) changing and how readily do you accept that change?
 4. Dale Bruner says that, "The best antidote to envy is the conviction of the sovereignty of God." What does that mean to you and do you agree with his statement?
 5. Read John 3:27-29 in The Message. (You can find The Message on your smartphone or at Bible Gateway on your computer.) How does reading this version make you think differently about JTB as he restates his role?
 6. Read verse 30 aloud one time. Take 3 minutes to meditate on it and what it means. Then share: How can you apply verse 30 in your own life?
