- 3. In verse 22, why the mention of Reuben's sleeping with Bilhah? What does Israel's response suggest? Look up Geneses 49:3-4.
- 4. Esau and Jacob are together again to bury their father. What is the significance of this? How have you seen the death of a parent impact a family?
- 5. Bible commentator Walter Brueggemann says of this passage, "Dying always happens in the midst of new life. Living always happens in the midst of death." Is there a time when someone's death taught you something about new life?
- 6. As you consider the journey of Jacob (Genesis 25:19 36:29), what thoughts and feelings emerge most strongly? What have you learned?


