Lenten Banners

The banners hanging on the Sanctuary walls contain images that point to the historical events of Lent and Holy Week. The initials INRI (Latin: *Iēsus Nazarēnus, Rēx Iūdaeōrum*) represent the Latin inscription (as in John 19:19), which in English translates to *Jesus the Nazarene, King of the Jews*, and John 19:20 states that this was written in three languages—Hebrew, Latin, and Greek—during the crucifixion of Jesus.
