Lenten Banners

The banners hanging on the Sanctuary walls contain images that point to the historical events of Lent and Holy Week. The initials INRI (Latin: lēsus Nazarēnus, Rēx Iūdaeōrum) represent the Latin inscription (as in John 19:19), which in English translates to *Jesus the Nazarene, King of the Jews*, and John 19:20 states that this was written in three languages—Hebrew, Latin, and Greek—during the crucifixion of Jesus.

Matthew 20:1-16

Icebreaker:

What was your first real job and how much money did you make?

Read this week's scripture and discuss:

- 1. Author James Bryan Smith asks about this parable, "If this is the only story you heard about God, what would you conclude?"
- 2. In the parable, how would you characterize the landowner? Thinking from the perspectives of the workers, how would you feel?
- 3. The landowner says in verse 13, "Friend, I am doing no wrong." Another translation says the owner is "not being unfair." Each worker receives the same wage. Is the owner unfair? Is God's grace fair? Is being generous fair?
- 4. The workers hired later are paid the same (one denarius) for less work. Do you rejoice when others benefit and you do not?
- 5. The landowner is generous. Is it possible to be too generous? Why or why not?
- 6. When author Dale Bruner reflects on this parable, he says judgment day will be a day of surprises. Does that make you excited, sad, or nervous?
