

Ice Breaker Question:
What do you have planned for Memorial Day weekend?

Read and discuss Mark 12:28-31, Romans 12:9-21

1. It's critical to understand that Paul's command to love other brothers and sisters in Christ as well as those out in the world is a response to the love we have received from God. Why is it important for us to remember that?
2. Paul tells us to outdo one another in showing honor. That sounds wonderful in theory, but what does that look like in practice? Can you think of a time when you have "outdone" someone or when they have "outdone" you when showing honor?
3. Paul calls us to live peaceably with all. Does your neighborhood now (or in the past) have conflict? What might you do to help bring peace into that situation?
4. Do you think living peaceably is the same thing as being polite? What happens when you seek to live authentically, but it doesn't bring peace?
5. Compare what you read about Saul (whose name is changed to Paul upon his conversion) in Acts 7:54-8:1 to what we read about Paul in Romans 12. What are your thoughts about these two passages? How have you experienced, either personally or through another person, God's transforming power?
6. Paul says, "never avenge yourselves, but leave room for the wrath of God; for it is written, 'Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord.'" He goes on to say, "No, 'if your enemies are hungry, feed them; if they are thirsty, give them something to drink; for by doing this you will heap burning coals on their heads.'" Do you find these statements to be contradictory? How do we balance the focus on judgment in our lives?
7. What has been your biggest takeaway from this neighboring series? What step(s) did you take during the last 7 weeks to love your literal neighbor? What might you do over the summer to reflect the love of God to those in your neighborhood?

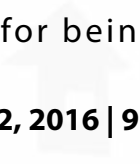
