## **HOME GROUP QUESTIONS**

Week 5 | 5.7.23 Seeing Jesus Anew

Scripture: Luke 9:18-27

#### **Group gathering question:**

When you meet someone, what is a first question you ask them: What do you do for a living? Where do you live? Who is in your family? Or a different question?

#### **Practice: Lectio Divina.**

Please read Luke 9:18-27 slowly aloud twice. You can have different readers. Take 30-60 seconds of quiet after each reading. Then ask the group to share, "What stands out to you in this passage?"

#### **Questions:**

- 1. When Jesus asks the disciples, "Who do the crowds say that I am?" it seems like an opinion poll. Why would Jesus be interested in what the crowds think? Why does he ask the follow-up question in verse 20?
- 2. Peter answered Jesus, "The Christ of God" or "God's Messiah." If people asked us today who is Jesus, we might not say Messiah. How else do people describe Jesus today?
- 3. Reading verse 23 again. What does it mean to deny yourself, take up your cross, and follow Jesus? Are there areas in your life where you could practice sacrifice or denial? Have you tried this before and, if so, how did it go?
- 4. In what ways does denying one's self make him or her more free?
- 5. N.T. Wright says that Jesus is telling the Twelve that there "is a dark and dangerous time ahead." Jesus will suffer and die and whoever wants to save his life will lose it. Do you think we (as modern churches or Christians) talk too much about God's love and grace? Do we downplay or talk too little about the surrender and sacrifice of following Jesus?
