HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 3 | 9.24.23
Seeing Jesus Anew

Scripture:
Luke 15:1-10

Group gathering question:

Have you ever lost valuable jewelry or your wallet or purse? Or have you ever lost track of a pet or a child? Share with your group what happened.

Read this week's scripture and discuss:

1. As you look at each parable who is the subject of the parable? How does this help us to see what the focus of the parable is?
2. Why do you think God uses parables?
3. How do you think the Pharisees heard these two parables?
4. In Jesus' parable of the sheep – do you align more with the 99 or the 1? Do you feel more like the 99 – someone who is on the right track in your faith with God; or like one who is lost or was lost and is now found?
5. Have you ever been physically lost on a trip or away from home? Have you ever felt spiritually lost or that you've lost your direction in life? What was that like? How did you find your way back?
6. If you identify with the lost sheep or the lost coin, how do these parables make you feel about your value to God?
