

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 6 | 10.15.23 Seeing Jesus Anew Scripture: Luke 16:14-31

Group gathering question:

What did you believe about heaven as a child? As an adult, has anything changed in what you think about heaven?

Read this week's scripture and discuss:

- 1. Verse 16 says people try to force their way into the kingdom of God. The rich man in the story expected to be in heaven. How do you think people try to force their way into heaven or expect to be in heaven?
- 2. How do the lives of the rich man and Lazarus compare on earth? After death? After death, why is the rich man in torment and Lazarus comforted?
- 3. Lazarus is silent throughout the parable that bears his name. What voice should we give him? Would he plead on behalf of the rich man, because he himself understands agony? Or would he gloat? If we were Lazarus, what would we do?
- 4. Concerning the parable, with whom do you identify: the rich man? Lazarus? How does "the resurrection from the dead" function in this parable—and in your life?
- 5. The rich man's brothers have enough information or knowledge (Moses and the Prophets, verse 29), so what are they lacking?
- 6. In comparison to the rest of the world, most ZPC'ers are wealthy. If Jesus commented on our wealth today, what do you think he would say?
