HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 7 | 10.22.23
Seeing Jesus Anew

Scripture:
Luke 17:1-10

Group Gathering Question:

When you were a child or teen, what was something a sibling or friend could do to "trigger" you and make you mad?

Read this week's scripture and discuss:

1. Our passage in Luke 17 can be divided into four parts: vs.1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-10. Choose a word or a phrase for each part that best summarizes it's meaning. Which of the four parts is most compelling for you? Why?
2. What does Jesus mean in verse 1? What might be an example of what Jesus is saying here?
3. After Jesus tells his disciples to forgive someone who sins seven times but repents, the disciples reply with, "Increase our faith!" When you take a moment to think about it, why would the disciples ask Jesus to increase their faith?
4. In verse 6, Jesus responds to the disciples' plea to increase their faith. What does his response about faith as small as a mustard seed really mean? Do you think your faith is small? What might a great God do with a little faith?
5. Reading verses 7-10, what attitudes should Jesus' followers have in serving? Do you struggle with committing to serve? Or serving too much?
6. It has been said that a strange title for a book would be, "Humility and How I Achieved It." The points Jesus makes in Luke 17 are mostly about being humble with God and others. How does one "achieve" humility?
