

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 8 | 10.29.23 **Seeing Jesus Anew**

Scripture: Luke 17:11-19

Group gathering question:

One leper came back to thank Jesus. In saying thank you, do you still hand write thank you notes? Or do you write a thank you text message or call someone? Or do you mostly say thank you face to face?

Read this week's scripture and discuss:

- 1. Can you imagine the life of a leper? Have you ever been an "outsider"? What was that like?
- 2. From this incident, how would you characterize Jesus? Consider all verses in this short story.
- 3. In your life today, do you think your faith looks like the nine who were healed, but didn't return to give thanks to Jesus or the one who returned and gave thanks?
- 4. The phrase in v. 19 "your faith has made you well" can also be translated "your faith has saved you" or "your faith has made you whole." What new insights do these translations give? What do you think is the same/ different about physical and spiritual healing?
- 5. When Jesus says "rise" or "get up" in verse 19, it is a word having to do with resurrection. How has this man had sort of a resurrection? What kind of resurrection do you need today?
- 6. What is a spiritual practice you can engage in this week that will help you to see God more clearly in your life?
