

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 9 | 11.5.23 Seeing Jesus Anew

Scripture: Luke 17:20-37

Group gathering question:

Disciples were looking forward to the coming of the kingdom of God. What are you looking forward to right now?

Read this week's scripture and discuss:

- 1. In answering the Pharisees' question, what does Jesus say about the kingdom of God as to when, how, or where it is?
- 2. The phrase at the end of verse 21 can be translated the kingdom of God "is among you" or "is within you" or even "is within your grasp." N.T. Wright says that the kingdom of God is active, "waiting for you to sign on." Discuss these different translations and how the kingdom of God can be active for us today.
- 3. This passage can be somewhat mysterious. Why do you think Luke wrote it that way in the first century? What might we learn about Jesus from how he tells this story?
- 4. As you think about this passage, try and take something from Jesus' teaching here and put it into your own words to share with your group.
- 5. When you live in the "kingdom" today and wait for "the Son of Man" to come back, what can we learn from Jesus's words? Specifically, how might we apply verses 32-33 today?
- 6. Dallas Willard says, "Churches are not the kingdom of God, but are primary and inevitable expressions, outposts, and instrumentalities of the presence of the kingdom among us." What does this mean to you? Do you agree or disagree?
