Cookies for Habitat | Thursday, Dec 7 | 8-9:30 am

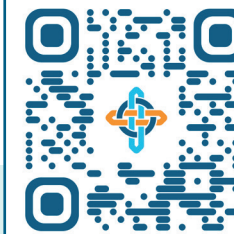
