CAM Christmas help update

The ZPC Community Assistance Ministry served 48 families this year, with a total of 155 children. Each family received \$50 per child to help with Christmas gifts. Forty-six of the 48 families received a laundry basket filled with household items and food for a holiday meal complete with a turkey or ham as well as some snacks donated by the Zionsville Food Pantry. The Mission Commission donated \$3,000. ZPC Littles colored cards for each family. ZPCers donated 41 laundry baskets filled with household items, 23 gift cards (totaling \$17,000), and \$4,035 in cash. Thank you to all who participated!

Operation Christmas Child Update

ZPC distributed 250 Operation Christmas Child boxes and received 257 boxes back! When boxes were dropped off, they were prayed over and the ZPC congregation was given many thanks.
