HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 3 | 4.21.24 Seeing Jesus Anew Scripture: Luke 24:36-53

Group Gathering Question:

We've been studying Luke since September 2022! When you think back to that time, what do you notice has changed for you? When you think about the book of Luke, what is one thing that stands out to you?

Read this week's Scripture and discuss these questions.

- 1. How is "Peace be with you" a good summary of the gospel or a good way to greet confused or wondering disciples?
- 2. Why is it important that Jesus tells the disciples to look closely at his hands and feet and eat something in front of them?
- 3. Why does Jesus do something similar with them (in verses 44-49) that he did on the road to Emmaus? Why is it important that the disciples hear this again?
- 4. Why do the disciples react so differently in verses 50-53 than when Jesus was taken away by the crucifixion?
- 5. The disciples are told to stay in the city, to wait, for the power to come on high before they go out in God's name. What do you think it means to wait upon the Lord? Do you have an example of a time when you waited before God?
- 6. Blessing is incredibly important throughout Luke and in Sunday's passage. How would you define a blessing? Who are those in your life who have blessed you, who have delighted in you, and what difference has that made in your life?
