Week 7 | 5.19.24

Ephesians: The Surprising Church

Scripture:

Ephesians 2:11-22

Group Gathering Question:

In this week's passage, Paul talks about Gentiles and Jews, citizens and strangers. From where did your ancestors emigrate? Have you done any research or testing to see where your family has its roots?

Also, take a few moments to discuss if you will get together this summer for something fun or for service.

Read this week's Scripture and discuss these questions.

1. Paul is certainly repetitive in these first couple of chapters of Ephesians. What would you suggest is the main theme?
2. Before Jesus came, what problems did Gentiles face, especially if they lived in Israel?
3. How did Jesus destroy barriers or "the dividing wall of hostility" for the church in Ephesus? How has Jesus destroyed dividing walls for us and for the church today?
4. Paul uses the word peace several times. What does it mean that Jesus himself is our peace? When you think of Jesus being peace, and that Jesus proclaims peace, what does it mean to you personally or in our troubled world today?
5. Tim Keller (and others) argue that for most of us our identity comes from how we compare to others. Do you agree or disagree? How might this lead to peace or to non-peace in our lives?
6. Lastly, Paul says we are "fellow citizens with the saints and also members of the household of God." Also in Jesus, we are being built into a "dwelling place for God." Of these three statements: fellow citizens with saints, members of God's household, or being a dwelling place for God; which resonates the most with you? Which resonates the least with you?
