1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the passage, what is it that stands out to you? Please share one word, phrase, or verse.

Learn

3. Paul says that some people say, "I follow Paul," or Apollos or Cephas or Christ. What current person would you be tempted to follow? If we are called to be followers of Jesus, what does that mean or what does that look like?
4. In what ways does this week's scripture reflect our culture right now? How do you think God calls us to show up in the midst of this?

Live

5. What might you be called to sacrifice (at church, in your family, in our society) in order to cultivate unity?
6. What is the particular invitation of the Holy Spirit to me or to our group through this week's passage or sermon?
