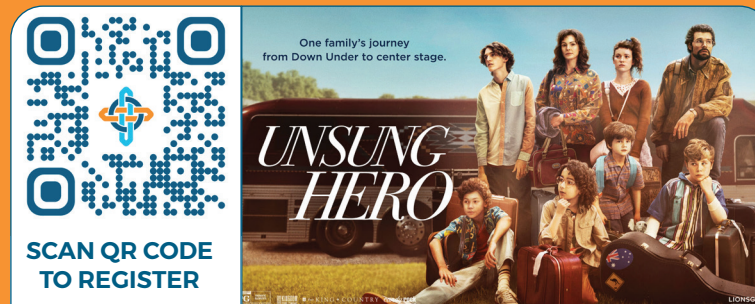

Week 3 | 9.28.25

1 Corinthians | A Jesus Community

Scripture:

1 Corinthians 2:6-3:4

Discover

1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the passage, what is it that stands out to you? Please share one word, phrase or verse.

Learn

3. In last week's passage, we read about the wisdom of the world, or the wisdom of the scholar. In 2:7-9, we read about God's secret wisdom, or God's hidden wisdom. What is this hidden wisdom (perhaps that seems foolish to the world)?
4. Reading verse 16 again, do you feel that you have "the mind of Christ?" Do you sometimes sense the Holy Spirit guiding you, similar to what Paul says here?

5. What is a practical way you can make a shift toward the scandalous cross, toward the foolish way of living for the crucified savior?
6. What is the particular invitation of the Holy Spirit to me or to our group through this week's passage or sermon?
